Halloween Safety Tips:

The spooky season is upon us! Here are some important tips to keep your dog safe during Halloween:

- Avoid dangerous treats: Chocolate and candy are toxic to dogs. Stick to pet-safe snacks.
- Calm their nerves: With doorbells ringing all night, set up a quiet space where your pup can relax.
- Beware of costumes: If your dog isn't a fan of dressing up, don't force it! Choose a comfortable option or let them go au naturel.
- Human costumes: Some may not like their human dressed up either, it can scare them. So be sure to ease them into your costume by leaving your mask off when first greeting them or leaving the parrot off of your shoulder until after you leave your house.


PUMPKIN TREATS

- 1/3 cup peanut butter (xylitol-free)
- Mix & roll into small balls
- Bake at 350°F for 10-15 minutes.

Please remember that chocolate is toxic for dogs and much of the other Halloween candy can make our pets sick. Be sure to keep it out of their reach.

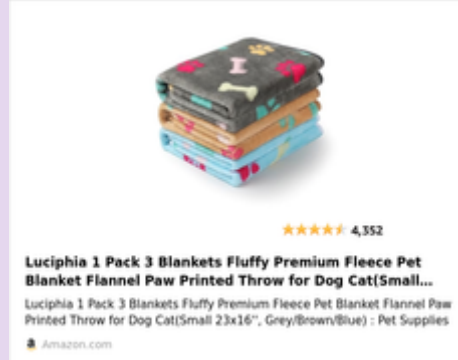

- Bring Treats: Reward your dog with their favorite treats throughout the visit. This helps create positive associations with the vet's office.
- Stay Calm: Dogs pick up on our emotions. If you're calm and relaxed, they're more likely to feel at ease too.
- Make It Fun: If possible, drop by the vet's office occasionally just for a visit and a treat—without an exam—so they associate the space with positive experiences.
