JACKRABBIT PARENT PORTAL

Studio Communication

Our main form of communication is **EMAIL**. Please make sure the email address you have provided on your account is active and your account receives our emails to your inbox.

Parent Watching

Supernova has an **open door policy**, but we encourage parents to drop off only, as sitting right outside the doors can be distracting to our dancers. But definitely feel free to come and watch the last few minutes of a class once in a while!

If your child is under age 5 you are more than welcome to stay in the studio.

TUITION PAYMENTS

Tuition is posted on the 1st of each month and any account adjustments will be reflected by the 3rd (except for September).

Each account must have a valid credit card, but we offer 2 options for payment:

1) **Credit Card** - add your preferred credit card to your Jackrabbit account and we will charge tuition fees on the 5th of each month.

2) **E-transfer** - once account adjustments are completed, you can send an e-transfer **prior to the 5th** of each month to supernovaacrostudio@gmail.com. Make sure to include your dancers name in the notes field as well as what the e-transfer is specifically paying for. Families who send us an e-transfer **prior** to the 5th will not have their credit card charged.

Declined Credit Cards: A \$25 fee will be applied to all declined credit cards that are not resolved within 24 hrs.

Class Withdrawals: Written notice **1 month prior** to the next bill date **MUST** be sent via email to supernovaacrostudio@gmail.com.

There will be **NO REFUNDS** for "no show" dancers as it is the parents responsibility to check Jackrabbit and let us know if there are any discrepancies.

Class Attire

ACRO TECH, MINIMITES, CHOREO & STRETCH CLASSES

CLOTHING: black bodysuit or tank/half top and shorts/leggings. NO BAGGY clothes please. (Colors are fine, but black is required for all exams)

HAIR: must be in a bun or braids tucked up (no exceptions) unless your hair isn't long enough. (Having hair in a messy ponytail is dangerous, as it can get stepped on and in the way when your dancer is being spotted).

BOYS: t-shirt/tank & shorts (tighter fitting if possible)

DANCE CLASSES

BALLET TECH (MINI, 1 & 2): bodysuit, pink ballet tights & pink ballet shoes (**no t-shirts)

BALLET TECH (3 & 4): bodysuit & pink ballet shoes (no tights required) (**no t-shirts)

JAZZ (ALL LEVELS): any color bodysuit OR half top and shorts/leggings & beige jazz shoes

CONTEMPORARY: same clothing as Jazz

HIP HOP: any loose fitting clothes

BOYS: t-shirt/tank & shorts (tighter fitting if possible)

HAIR

ALL CLASSES: hair must be pulled back with no fly aways. Please do not have long pony tails (other than for Hip Hop)

Class Attendance

Consistent attendance is a huge part of a dancer's success in Acro! Acro skills build on one another. Regular attendance allows dancers to stay on track, build strength and flexibility, improve technique, and safely progress through their skills.

When dancers miss classes, they can miss important progressions and instruction, which can make it more difficult to keep up with the rest of the class.

We understand that life happens and occasional absences are unavoidable. However, regular attendance is required and is one of the best ways to help your dancer get the most out of their acro training.

Competition Attendance:

January & February are super important months NOT to miss classes, especially choreo classes. We are expecting all dancers to be at all choreo classes the 2 weeks leading up to each competition as well as before our Showcase and Recital.

Additional Attire: All competitive dancers will need to have the most up to date comp jackets! An order form will be sent out to families.

Costume Deposits: All costumes will have deposits added to your Jackrabbit accounts.

STUDIO POLICIES

- Supernova requires **1 months notice via email** for any classes that your dancer would like to drop. There will be NO refunds for “no show” dancers. It is the parents responsibility to check Jackrabbit and let us know if there are any discrepancies.
- A **valid credit card** is required on all accounts, but we are happy to accept an e-transfer for payment if it is sent prior to the 5th of each month.
- Any accounts that have a **declined credit card** for payment on our monthly charges will have a \$25 fee added to their account if not cleared within 24hrs.
- **Competition Attendance:** We EXPECT all dancers to be at each competition as well as our Showcase and Recital. In addition, we would prefer no travel during January & February as these are crucial months for choreo classes.

STUDIO WAIVER 2026-2027

Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk (the “Release”)

By signing below, the individual [identified as a participant] (“Participant”) (or if the Participant is a minor, the individual identified as the legal guardian or parent of the Participant who is over the age of eighteen (18) (“Parent”)), in each case, [on the registration form] submitted to SUPERNOVA ACRO, an Alberta corporation (the “Company”), hereby accepts and agrees to the terms of this release (the “Release”). The Participant desires to attend or participate in dance-related instructional courses, demonstration, workshops and any other activities (collectively, the “Activity”) provided by SUPERNOVA ACRO or conducted at a premises made available by SUPERNOVA ACRO. In consideration of being permitted by SUPERNOVA ACRO to attend or participate in the Activity, the Participant and the Parent, if any, on behalf of themselves and the Participant voluntarily and freely agrees to all the terms and conditions in this Release.

I hereby consent for my child to receive medical or first-aid treatment deemed necessary if they are injured or require medical attention during or in connection with participation in the Activity. I understand and agree that I am solely responsible for all costs related to such medical treatment. I hereby release, forever discharge, and hold harmless SUPERNOVA ACRO from any claim based on such treatment or medical services.

I am aware and understand that the Activity is a physical activity that is potentially dangerous and involves the risk of personal, bodily or psychological injury, illness, pain, suffering, temporary or permanent disability, death, property damage, and/or financial loss. I acknowledge that any such injuries that my child sustains may result from or be compounded by the actions, omissions, or negligence of the company, including negligent emergency response or negligent rescue operations of the company. **Notwithstanding the risk, I acknowledge that myself and my child are knowingly and voluntarily participating in the activity with an express understanding of the danger involved and hereby agree to accept and assume any and all risks of personal, bodily or psychological injury, illness, disability, death, property damage and/or financial loss arising from my child's participation in the activity, whether caused by the ordinary negligence of SUPERNOVA or otherwise.**

I hereby expressly waive and release any and all claims, including, but not limited to; sprains, bruises, pulled muscles, broken bones, cold, flu, and property or financial loss, now known or hereafter known, against SUPERNOVA ACRO, and its officers, directors, managers, employees, agents, affiliates, successors and assigns, and any hosting facility (collectively, “the “Releasees”), arising out of or attributable to my attendance at, or participation in, the Activity, including but not limited to, claims that allege negligent acts or omissions of the Releasees, or claims arising from any statute, including, without limitation, the Occupiers’ Liability Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. O-4 (collectively, the “Claims”). I will not make or bring any such claim against SUPERNOVA or any other Releasee, and forever release and discharge SUPERNOVA ACRO and all other Releasees from liability under such claims. I will defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Releasees against any and all losses, damages, liabilities, deficiencies, claims, actions, judgments, settlements, interest, awards, penalties, fines, costs, or expenses of whatever kind (including but not limited to, costs associated with reasonable attorney fees, enforcing any right to indemnification under this Release, and pursuing any insurance providers) related to any Claim. Release of Video and Photography. By attending and/or participating in the Activity, I grant permission to SUPERNOVA to record my attendance at, and/or participation in, the Activity and consent to the use of my images, photographs or appearance in any videos, television, or any other electronic media for marketing, advertising, news coverage, or any other commercial use of the Company’s Activity. Additionally, I hereby irrevocably assign any right, title and interest they may have in any such images and recordings and waive any right to royalties or other compensation arising from the use of any such image or recording.

This Release constitutes the sole and entire agreement between myself, my child and SUPERNOVA ACRO with respect to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements. If any term or provision of this Release is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability will not affect any other term or provision of this Release. This Release is binding on and will inure to the benefit of all parties and each party’s respective heirs, successors, and assigns. All matters arising out of or relating to this Release will be governed by the internal laws of the Province of Alberta, and the federal laws of Canada applicable in Alberta, and this Release shall in all respects be deemed a contract made in Alberta. Any claim or cause of action arising under this Release may be brought only in the courts of the Province of Alberta, or the Federal Court of Canada to the extent it has exclusive jurisdiction, in either case, sitting at Calgary, and I hereby consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of such courts.

By signing below, I acknowledge that (1) I am the parent or legal guardian of the participant and I have the legal right to consent to the terms and conditions of this release on behalf of myself and the participant, (2.) I have read the legal right to consent to the terms and conditions of this release and (3) I am voluntarily giving up substantial legal rights, including the right to sue SUPERNOVA ACRO on behalf of myself and the participant.
