We've held several fun events (Veteran's Day, Texas/Texas A&M game, and the Army/Navy game) and raised a little money for all of our entities in the process. As always, none of our events would be a success without the support of our members' participation; purchasing tickets/auction items and having a few cold beverages in the process. On December 27th we received our first wave of new V-Sweep machines. The software that runs the current machines is being discontinued, so this is a necessary change.
