He humbled you and let you be hungry and fed you with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that He might make you understand that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD."
- ✓ **Exodus 20:20** – Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid; for God has come in order to test you, and in order that the fear of Him may remain with you, so that you may not sin."
- ✓ **Deuteronomy 8:16** – "In the wilderness He fed you manna which your fathers did not know that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do good for you in the end."
- ✓ **Deuteronomy 13:3-4** – You shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams; for the LORD, your God is testing you to find out if you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. "You shall follow the LORD your God and fear Him; and you shall keep His commandments, listen to His voice, serve Him, and cling to Him."



- ✓ **Genesis 22:1-2** – Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you."
- ✓ **Judges 7:4-7** – Then the LORD said to Gideon, "The people are still too many; bring them down to the water and I will test them for you there. Therefore, it shall be that he of whom I say to you, 'This one shall go with you,' he shall go with you; but every one of whom I say to you, 'This one shall not go with you,' he shall not go." So, he brought the people down to the water. And the LORD said to Gideon, "You shall separate everyone who laps the water with his tongue as a dog laps, as well as everyone who kneels to drink." Now the number of those who lapped, putting their hand to their mouth, was 300 men; but all the rest of the people knelt to drink water."
- ✓ **2 Chronicles 32:31** – Even in the matter of the envoys of the rulers of Babylon, who sent to him to inquire of the wonder that had happened in the land, God left him alone only to test him, that He might know all that was in his heart.
- ✓ **2 Corinthians 12:7-9** – Because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, for this reason, to keep me from exalting myself, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me--to keep me from exalting myself! Concerning this, I implored the Lord three times so that it might leave me. And He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me.
- ✓ **John 6:5-6** – Therefore Jesus, lifting up His eyes and seeing that a large crowd was coming to Him, said to Philip, "Where are we to buy bread, so that these may eat?" This He was saying to test him, for He Himself knew what He was intending to do.
- ✓ **Matthew 15:22-28** – And a Canaanite woman from that region came out and began to cry out, saying, "Have mercy on me, Lord, Son of David; my daughter is cruelly demon-possessed." But He did not answer her a word. And His disciples came and implored Him, saying, "Send her away, because she keeps shouting at us." But He answered and said, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."
- ✓ **Mark 7:25-30** – But after hearing of Him, a woman whose little daughter had an unclean spirit immediately came and fell at His feet. Now the woman was a Gentile, of the Syrophoenician race. And she kept asking Him to cast the demon out of her daughter.



And He was saying to her, "Let the children be satisfied first, for it is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs."

- ✓ **Mark 8:17-21** – And Jesus, aware of this, said to them, "Why do you discuss the fact that you have no bread? Do you not yet see or understand? Do you have a hardened heart? "HAVING EYES, DO YOU NOT SEE? AND HAVING EARS, DO YOU NOT HEAR? And do you not remember, when I broke the five loaves for the five thousand, how many baskets full of broken pieces you picked up?" They said to Him, "Twelve." read more.
- ✓ **Romans 12:2** – And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
- ✓ **Psalms 17:3** – You have tried my heart; You have visited me by night; You have tested me, and You find nothing; I have purposed that my mouth will not transgress.
- ✓ **Psalms 26:2** – Examine me, O LORD, and try me; Test my mind and my heart.
- ✓ **Psalms 139:23** – Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me and know my anxious thoughts
- ✓ **Lamentations 3:40** – Let us examine and probe our ways And let us return to the LORD.
- ✓ **2 Corinthians 13:5** – Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you--unless indeed you fail the test?
- ✓ **Galatians 6:4** – But each one must examine his own work, and then he will have reason for boasting in regard to himself alone, and not in regard to another.
- ✓ **1 Thessalonians 5:21** – But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good
- ✓ **1 Corinthians 3:12-15** – Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.



- ✓ **Malachi 3:10** – "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, and test Me now in this," says the LORD of hosts, "if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows."
- ✓ **Judges 6:39** – Then Gideon said to God, "Do not let Your anger burn against me that I may speak once more; please let me make a test once more with the fleece, let it now be dry only on the fleece, and let there be dew on all the ground."
- ✓ **Exodus 17:2** – Therefore the people quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water that we may drink " And Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test the LORD?"
- ✓ **Exodus 17:7** – He named the place Massah and Meribah because of the quarrel of the sons of Israel, and because they tested the LORD, saying, "Is the LORD among us, or not?"
- ✓ **Numbers 14:22-23** – "Surely all the men who have seen My glory and My signs which I performed in Egypt and in the wilderness yet have put Me to the test these ten times and have not listened to My voice, shall by no means see the land which I swore to their fathers, nor shall any of those who spurned Me see it."
- ✓ **Deuteronomy 6:16** – "You shall not put the LORD your God to the test, as you tested Him at Massah."
- ✓ **Deuteronomy 33:8** – Of Levi he said, "Let Your Thummim and Your Urim belong to Your godly man, Whom You proved at Massah, With whom You contended at the waters of Meribah"
- ✓ **Psalms 78:18** – And in their heart, they put God to the test By asking food according to their desire.
- ✓ **Psalms 95:8** – Do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, As in the day of Massah in the wilderness
- ✓ **Matthew 4:7** – Jesus said to him, "On the other hand, it is written, 'YOU SHALL NOT PUT THE LORD YOUR GOD TO THE TEST.'"
- ✓ **Luke 4:12** – And Jesus answered and said to him, "It is said, 'YOU SHALL NOT PUT THE LORD YOUR GOD TO THE TEST.'"



- ✓ **Matthew 19:3** – Some Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any reason at all?"
- ✓ **Mark 10:2** – Some Pharisees came up to Jesus, testing Him, and began to question Him whether it was lawful for a man to divorce a wife.
- ✓ **Acts 5:9** – Then Peter said to her, "Why is it that you have agreed together to put the Spirit of the Lord to the test? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out as well."
- ✓ **Acts 15:10** – "Now therefore why do you put God to the test by placing upon the neck of the disciples a yoke which neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear?"
- ✓ **Hebrews 3:8-9** – DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS AS WHEN THEY PROVOKED ME, AS IN THE DAY OF TRIAL IN THE WILDERNESS, WHERE YOUR FATHERS TRIED Me BY TESTING Me, AND SAW MY WORKS FOR FORTY YEARS.
- ✓ **1 John 4:1** – Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

- ✓ **Isaiah 48:10** – "Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction."
- ✓ **1 Peter 4:12-16** – Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange things were happening to you; but to the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation. If you are reviled for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.



- ✓ **Isaiah 40:31** – Yet those who wait for the LORD Will gain new strength; They will mount up with wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired, They will walk and not become weary.
- ✓ **Genesis 22:1** – Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."
- ✓ **Luke 22:28** – "You are those who have stood by Me in My trials"
- ✓ **2 Corinthians 8:1-2** – Now, brethren, we wish to make known to you the grace of God which has been given in the churches of Macedonia, that in a great ordeal of affliction their abundance of joy and their deep poverty overflowed in the wealth of their liberality.

- ✓ **Revelation 7:14** – I said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."
- ✓ **Romans 5:3** – And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance
- ✓ **Revelation 2:9** – 'I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich), and the blasphemy by those who say they are Jews and are not but are a synagogue of Satan.'

- ✓ **Ezekiel 24:18** – So, I spoke to the people in the morning, and in the evening my wife died. And in the morning, I did as I was commanded.
- ✓ **1 Corinthians 4:11** – To this present hour we are both hungry and thirsty, and are poorly clothed, and are roughly treated, and are homeless.
- ✓ **2 Corinthians 6:5** – In beatings, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in hunger
- ✓ **2 Corinthians 11:23** – Are they servants of Christ?--I speak as if insane--I more so; in far more labors, in far more imprisonments, beaten times without number, often in danger of death.
