Definition | Meaning: Righteous Judgement – Righteous Justice

Righteous Definition Meaning (Merriam-Webster):

- (1) Acting in accord with divine or moral law: free from guilt or sin.
- (2a) Morally right or justifiable - a righteous decision - arising from an outraged sense of justice or morality (Righteous Indignation).
- (3) GENUINE, EXCELLENT.

Bible Meaning (<https://www.biblestudytools.com/dictionary/righteousness/>):

God the Father is righteous (just); Jesus Christ his Son is the Righteous (Just) One; the Father through the Son and in the Spirit gives the gift of righteousness (justice) to repentant sinners for salvation; such believing sinners are declared righteous (just) by the Father through the Son, are made righteous (just) by the Holy Spirit working in them and will be wholly righteous (just) in the age to come. They are and will be righteous because they are in a covenant relation with the



living God, who is the God of all grace and mercy and who will bring to completion what he has begun in them by declaring them righteous for Christ's sake.

Judgement Definition Meaning (Merriam-Webster):

- (1a) The process of forming an opinion or evaluation by discerning and comparing careful judgment of the odds.
- (b) An opinion or estimate so formed (is not worth doing in my judgment).
- (2a) The capacity for judging: DISCERNMENT (be guided by your own judgment). Showing poor judgment.
- (b) The exercise of this capacity (a situation requiring careful judgment).
- (3a) A formal utterance of an authoritative opinion.
- (b) An opinion so pronounced.
- (4a) A formal decision given by a court.
- (b)(1) An obligation (such as a debt) created by the decree of a court.
- (b)(2) A certificate evidencing such a decree.
- (5a) The final judging of humankind by God (sinners awaiting Judgment).
- (b) A divine sentence or decision (specifically: a calamity held to be sent by God).
- (6) A proposition stating something believed or asserted.

Bible Meaning (<https://www.biblestudytools.com/dictionary/judgment/>):

The Hebrew term mispat [f'P.vim] is an important Old Testament concept and one linked with God. It may denote the process whereby a verdict is reached or the verdict itself; it is bound up with the notions of justice (modern translations often have "justice" for mispat) and righteousness and it is of fundamental importance for biblical religion. Thus, Abraham could ask, "Will not the Judge of all the earth do mispat [f'P.vim]?" (Ge 18:25); it is fundamental that God engages in judgment. Indeed, God is the God of mispat [f'P.vim]. Judgment is essentially his own activity. Nobody taught him (Isa 40:14), and "all his ways are just" (Deut 32:4). Judgment is linked with righteousness as the foundation of his throne (Psalm 97:2). Judgment is as natural to God as the movements of the birds are to them (Jer 8:7).

Justice Definition Meaning (Merriam-Webster):



- (1a) The maintenance or administration of what is especially by the impartial adjustment of conflicting claims or the assignment of merited rewards or punishments (meting out justice - social justice).
- (b) JUDGE. Especially: A judge of an appellate court or court of last resort (as a supreme court). A supreme court justice.
- (c) The administration of law (a fugitive from justice). Especially: the establishment or determination of rights according to the rules of law or equity (a system of justice).
- (2a) The quality of being just, impartial, or fair (questioned the justice of their decision).
- (b)(1) The principle or ideal of just dealing or right action.
- (b)(2) Conformity to this principle or ideal: RIGHTEOUSNESS (the justice of their cause).
- (c) The quality of conforming to law.
- (3) Conformity to truth, fact, or reason: CORRECTNESS (admitted that there was much justice in these observations).

Bible Meaning (<https://www.biblestudytools.com/dictionary/justice/>):

(Heb. sedeq [q, d, x], mispat [f'P.vim]; Gk. dikaiosyne [dikaio-suvnh]). God, the Righteous Judge. Justice is rooted in the very nature of God (Isa 40:14). He evenhandedly rewards good, and he does not ignore the sins of any (Psalm 33:5; Psalms 37:6 Psalms 37:28; 97:2; 99:4). Human judges do well to remember God in their courts. God does not take bribes (Deut 10:17) or pervert justice in any way (Gen 18:25; 2 Chron 19:7).

At the same time, God rarely delivers instant justice. The world does not seem fair while evil still abounds, and so the oppressed petition God to intervene on their behalf (Psalm 7:9; Prov 29:26). Their prayers may even take the form of a complaint (Hab 1:2-4), although people must not challenge God's essential justice (Job 40:8; Mal 2:17). That God will decisively intervene in the future is the biblical hope.

Prayers – Righteous Judgement

Soften each heart. We pray for one another, and we pray for all people everywhere in these last days – YOUR harvest – YOUR Last Rain!

Romans 2:5 (ESV) But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed.

YOU desire judges to judge the people with YOUR righteous judgement!

Deuteronomy 16:18 (ESV) "You shall appoint judges and officers in all your towns that the Lord your God is giving you, according to your tribes, and they shall judge the people with righteous judgment."

Desiring, Thinking, Saying are Different than Doing!

Do YOUR work in each heart so that our desires are in line with YOU, our thinking is in the Word, our words glorify YOU, and our actions show Jesus!



Isaiah 58:2 (ESV) Yet they seek me daily and delight to know my ways, as if they were a nation that did righteousness and did not forsake the judgment of their God; they ask of me righteous judgments; they delight to draw near to God.

There is a time when YOUR wrath shall come, the dead to be judged, for rewarding YOUR servants, rewarding YOUR prophets and saints. YOU shall do this with both small and great, for those who fear YOUR name.

Jesus, we pray and do whatever it takes for more people to know YOU!

Revelation 11:18 (ESV) “The nations raged, but your wrath came, and the time for the dead to be judged, and for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints, and those who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying the destroyers of the earth.”

This spoken and true event and action is coming!

Father God, let us stay in YOU, alert, ready, following YOU, listening, and doing in Jesus!

2 Peter 3:7 (ESV) But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

What does God feel every day?

Indignation Means (Merriam-Webster): “Anger aroused by something unjust, unworthy, or mean.”

Psalms 7:11 (ESV) God is a righteous judge, and a God who feels indignation every day.

God is righteous and His rules are right!

Psalms 119:137 (ESV) Righteous are you, O Lord, and right are your rules.

The righteous have blessings on their head from God. The wicked conceal violence in their mouths.

Father God, we need YOUR leading, presence, steps, fear of the LORD, and directions!

Proverbs 10:6 (ESV) Blessings are on the head of the righteous, but the mouth of the wicked conceals violence.

What are the thoughts of the righteous? What are the counsels of the wicked?



WE pray for YOUR awakening, YOUR presence, YOUR revival, YOUR Holy Spirit, YOUR outpouring, YOUR Last Rain in each heart in Jesus' name!

Proverbs 12:5 (ESV) The thoughts of the righteous are just; the counsels of the wicked are deceitful.

What does the LORD do?

- He judges the peoples!

IN accordance with what?

- Our righteousness and integrity found in us!

Father God, we pray for YOUR righteousness in Jesus, righteousness in our desires thoughts words and actions, and for integrity from YOU in all we are in Jesus' name!

Psalms 7:8 (ESV) The Lord judges the peoples; judge me, O Lord, according to my righteousness and according to the integrity that is in me.

How is the LORD God coming?!

Psalms 96:13 (ESV) Before the Lord, for he comes, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world in righteousness, and the peoples in his faithfulness.

What is the fear of the LORD like?

- Clean.

- Endures Forever.

What are the rules of the LORD like?!

- True.

- Righteous.

We pray for YOUR increase of the fear of the LORD in our lives and for increase of YOUR righteous rules in our entire being in Jesus' name!

Psalms 19:9 (ESV) The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the Lord are true, and righteous altogether.

Yes, in Jesus' name!

Psalms 72:2 (ESV) May he judge your people with righteousness, and your poor with justice!

Let us commit and confirm to keep YOUR righteous rules each moment, each day, forever!



Psalms 119:106 (ESV) I have sworn an oath and confirmed it, to keep your righteous rules.

We pray and embrace YOU to understand YOUR righteousness, YOUR justice, YOUR equity, and EVERY good path in YOU in Jesus name!

Proverbs 2:9 (ESV) Then you will understand righteousness and justice and equity, every good path.

We are seeing this increase right now!

Father God, we pray for YOUR people to rise forth and do as YOU desire. WE pray for more Cyrus's. WE pray for more people to follow YOU in righteous deeds. We pray for righteous indignation to well up in each one and for YOUR heavenly will and actions to take place on earth.

Proverbs 29:2 (ESV) When the righteous increase, the people rejoice, but when the wicked rule, the people groan.

What does a righteous person know? What does a wicked person not understand?

Proverbs 29:7 (ESV) A righteous man knows the rights of the poor; a wicked man does not understand such knowledge.

We pray for a softening of each heart, stubbornness to go away, for YOUR Holy Spirit move where we are at, in our area, in the region, in each nation, in Jesus' name!

Isaiah 46:12 (ESV) "Listen to me, you stubborn of heart, you who are far from righteousness."

Hear in Heaven Father God and act and judge YOUR servants.

Do YOUR righteous work. Show the distinction to the nations of those who are in relationship with YOU and those who are not so that MANY shall come to YOU and know YOU in Jesus name!

1 Kings 8:32 (ESV) Then hear in heaven and act and judge your servants, condemning the guilty by bringing his conduct on his own head, and vindicating the righteous by rewarding him according to his righteousness.

Establish YOUR righteous people in each place now and let the evil of the wicked end in Jesus' name!



YOU do test the minds and hearts so that we know what is in them.

Do YOUR work in each one of us Father for YOUR awesome glory and praise!

Psalms 7:9 (ESV) Oh, let the evil of the wicked end, and may you establish the righteous— you who test the minds and hearts, O righteous God!

YOU Save!

Psalms 36:6 (ESV) Your righteousness is like the mountains of God; your judgments are like the great deep; man, and beast you save, O Lord.

Through affliction in this life, we come closer to the LORD as we allow Him to do His work!

Psalms 119:75 (ESV) I know, O Lord, that your rules are righteous, and that in faithfulness you have afflicted me.

God does what is Just!

Let us trust Him, wait on Him and for Him, as He acts and does what is perfect and best!

Genesis 18:25 (ESV) “Far be it from you to do such a thing, to put the righteous to death with the wicked, so that the righteous fare as the wicked! Far be that from you! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do what is just?”

Our God rewards the diligent.

He is faithful to the faithful! He adds those things to those who seek Him first. “I AM” never leaves us nor forsakes us. Almighty God saves each of us as we are in Him. Let us believe and follow in Jesus in each moment!

2 Timothy 4:8 (ESV) Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

Let us commit ALL our causes to YOU!

Jeremiah 11:20 (ESV) But, O Lord of hosts, who judges righteously, who tests the heart and the mind, let me see your vengeance upon them, for to you have I committed my cause.

How do YOU want us to judge?

Father God, we pray for YOUR heart, YOUR love, YOUR righteousness, and YOUR justice!



Leviticus 19:15 (ESV) “You shall do no injustice in court. You shall not be partial to the poor or defer to the great, but in righteousness shall you judge your neighbor.

Let us not do things in our own ways and will. YOU tell us YOU bless those who wait for YOU and wait on YOU! WE place our entire hope in YOU as YOU are God, and YOU shall not disappoint!

Isaiah 51:5 (ESV) My righteousness draws near, my salvation has gone out, and my arms will judge the peoples; the coastlands hope for me, and [for my arm they wait](#).

Who shall surely live declare the LORD God.

Those Who:

- Walk in God’s Statutes.
- Keep His Rules by Acting Faithfully.
- Are Righteous in Jesus.

Let’s follow YOU ALL the way! Not by our power or might, but by the Holy Spirit Presence of God in Jesus name.

Ezekiel 18:9 (ESV) Walks in my statutes and keeps my rules by acting faithfully—he is righteous; he shall surely live, declares the Lord God.

Let us be YOUR heart Jesus.

Matthew 6:1 (ESV) “Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven.”

What does He do?

- He judges and makes war in righteousness!



Who is He?

Jesus – God!

What is He Called?

- Faithful.
- True.

Isaiah 11:4 (ESV) – But with righteousness he shall judge the poor and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

What does the LORD do?!

Let us do the same in Jesus!

Jeremiah 9:24 (ESV) “But let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the Lord.”

Thank YOU for salvation through Jesus.

Acts 17:31 (ESV) “Because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead.”

Prayers – Righteous Justice

Father God, let YOUR people arise in YOU, pray, do, and be ready for YOUR presence.

Habakkuk 1:4 (ESV) So, the law is paralyzed, and justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround, the righteous, so justice goes forth perverted.



What does the mouth and the tongue of the righteous do?

Psalms 37:30 (ESV) The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, and his tongue speaks justice.

Justice shall return in Jesus.

Psalms 94:15 (ESV) For justice will return to the righteous, and all the upright in heart will follow it.

YOU did this with Jesus.

Let us go forth in Jesus and do the same in His name!

Jeremiah 33:15 (ESV) In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch to spring up for David, and he shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.

How do YOU desire us to live our lives?

Deuteronomy 16:19 (ESV) You shall not pervert justice. You shall not show partiality, and you shall not accept a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and subverts the cause of the righteous.

What is the LORD like? What are the people like who follow Jesus?

WE pray together to be more like YOU, giving love to YOU and all those around us, led by YOU, in each moment in Jesus!

Zephaniah 3:5 (ESV) The Lord within her is righteous; he does no injustice; every morning he shows forth his justice; each dawn he does not fail; but the unjust knows no shame.

We do not have to fear!

Our God is with each of us, He gives us clarity and peace, He is our God, He strengthens us, He helps us, and He upholds each of us with His righteous right hand!

Isaiah 41:10 (ESV) Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Tribulation and distress to whom?

Romans 2:9 (ESV) There will be tribulation and distress for every human being who does evil, the Jew first and the Greek.



Let us do what is right and just in following Jesus.

Ezekiel 18:5 (ESV) “If a man is righteous and does what is just and right.”

How does God judge?!

- With righteousness and uprightness!

Father, let us be in YOU and do what YOU have directed us to desire, think, say, and do in Jesus.

Psalm 9:8 (ESV) And he judges the world with righteousness; he judges the peoples with uprightness.

YOU work righteousness and justice.

All things work together for the good, for those who are called according to YOUR purpose and will. Those who choose their Creator, Jesus, and follow, YOU do good things! WE can witness many in the Word, as well as those alive in this world, following YOU Jesus.

Do YOUR Work Father!

Psalm 103:6 (ESV) The Lord works righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed.

We pray for godly leadership, for righteous leaders, for leaders who rule in YOUR justice.

Isaiah 32:1 (ESV) Behold, a king will reign in righteousness, and princes will rule in justice.

There are many great things happening and coming as promised by God.

Father we give our heart over to YOU and we thank YOU for YOUR protection, shield over us, guiding our steps, sharing insight in what is and what is not from YOU, how to pray, and what to do!

Our God, I AM, the only and ONE God, loves justice.

Psalms 99:4 (ESV) The King in his might loves justice. You have established equity; you have executed justice and righteousness in Jacob.

Our God shows His steadfast love, His righteousness, and justice daily around the earth.

Let us be aware, listening, in tune, and allowing YOUR Holy Spirit and love in each situation to manifest in Jesus’ name.

Psalms 33:5 (ESV) He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the steadfast love of the Lord.

Proverbs 21:3 (ESV) To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice.

How is Zion redeemed?

- By justice!
- Those who repent by righteousness!

Father God, we pray for justice and righteousness to be in our very core, our heart, our mind, the words we speak, our actions, our every breath in Jesus' name!

Isaiah 1:27 (ESV) Zion shall be redeemed by justice, and those in her who repent, by righteousness.

YOU are exalted above ALL!

YOU show YOURSELF HOLY in Righteousness.

Isaiah 5:16 (ESV) But the Lord of hosts is exalted in justice, and the Holy God shows himself holy in righteousness.

By What?

- Truthful Speech.
- The Power of God.
- With THE Weapons of Righteousness.

Father God, let each one pray, press in, persevere, and praise YOU in the name of Jesus.

2 Corinthians 6:7 (ESV) By truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left.

What is the foundation of YOUR throne?

- Righteousness.
- Justice.

Father God, we stand, we stay on course, we seek YOU, and we stand fast in prayer, intercession, and covering in Jesus' name for God's righteousness and justice to show up in Jesus' name.

Proverbs 16:13 (ESV) Righteous lips are the delight of a king, and he loves him who speaks what is right.

God shall judge the righteous and the wicked at His time.

Let us trust the process, stay to the plan, and keep on believing in Jesus.

Ecclesiastes 3:17 (ESV) I said in my heart, God will judge the righteous and the wicked, for there is a time for every matter and for every work.

This shall happen for Israel.

Thank YOU, Father God, for ALWAYS fulfilling YOUR Word.

Isaiah 1:26 (ESV) “And I will restore your judges as at the first, and your counselors as at the beginning. Afterward you shall be called the city of righteousness, the faithful city.”

YOU are merciful, gracious, long suffering, kind, compassionate, and loving.

Hosea 2:19 (ESV) And I will betroth you to me forever. I will betroth you to me in righteousness and in justice, in steadfast love and in mercy.

Thank YOU for the way, the truth, life, salvation provided through Jesus.

YOU are the justifier, who justifies, anyone who believes Jesus and is saved!

Romans 3:26 (ESV) It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

We are made righteous, perfect, and redeemed to our Creator God, through Jesus.

Hebrews 12:23 (ESV) And to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect.

What are we to do and continue to do in this hour?

Revelation 22:11 (ESV) “Let the evildoer still do evil, and the filthy still be filthy, and the righteous still do right, and the holy still be holy.”



Lead each of us to desire, think, say, and do the love of God to YOU Father and all people in Jesus' name.

1 Kings 8:32 (ESV) Then hear in heaven and act and judge your servants, condemning the guilty by bringing his conduct on his own head, and vindicating the righteous by rewarding him according to his righteousness.

What Steps in this verse?

- Hear from heaven.
- Act and judge your servants.
- Repay the guilty.
- By bringing conduct on their own head.
- Vindicate the righteous.
- According to their righteousness.

Father God help us to live in and for YOU in Jesus.

2 Chronicles 6:23 (ESV) Then hear from heaven and act and judge your servants, repaying the guilty by bringing his conduct on his own head, and vindicating the righteous by rewarding him according to his righteousness.

There is a crown of righteousness from God, for all who are saved through Jesus.

2 Timothy 4:8 (ESV) Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

Send those from YOU who are to be appointed by YOU in each place in Jesus' name.

Deuteronomy 16:18 (ESV) "You shall appoint judges and officers in all your towns that the Lord your God is giving you, according to your tribes, and they shall judge the people with righteous judgment."

Victory is the LORD God's! YOUR cause is truth, meekness, and righteousness.

Let YOUR awesome deeds come forth through the people of God in Jesus name.

Psalms 45:4 (ESV) In your majesty ride out victoriously for the cause of truth and meekness and righteousness; let your right hand teach you awesome deeds!



Revival in Leadership in Jesus name.

Ecclesiastes 5:8 (ESV) If you see in a province the oppression of the poor and the violation of justice and righteousness, do not be amazed at the matter, for the high official is watched by a higher, and there are yet higher ones over them.

We wait for YOUR arm

Isaiah 51:5 (ESV) My righteousness draws near, my salvation has gone out, and my arms will judge the peoples; the coastlands hope for me, and for my arm they wait.

Jesus is Faithful, True, and He judges and makes war.

... Paul addresses his account of God's righteous judgment from the fifth verse to the sixteenth. Those who despise God's goodness have a great fact to face. Those who live as if there was no God, who evade his commandments, who evade his offer of salvation, cannot evade his righteous judgment. As there is one event to all in the universal certainty of death, so we must all appear before the judgment-seat of Christ. It is good even for Christians to be reminded of the judgment to come. We live too little under its power. We realize too imperfectly that one day we shall have to give an account of our stewardship. We realize our responsibility toward those around us imperfectly. How little we enter Paul's views of the judgment, when he said, "Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men" (2 Corinthians 5:11)! The subject of God's righteous judgment is an important one both for Christian and for sinner.

Psalms 9:4 (ESV) For you have maintained my just cause; you have sat on the throne, giving righteous judgment.

God: where righteousness and justice meet

*It seems that there is one place where it is OK to mix righteousness and justice: when discussing God. God is both just and righteous. His actions are just; his actions are right. We get a sense of this from Jeremiah 9:24: 'I am the Lord who exercise kindness, justice, and righteousness.' This sense of God's righteousness and justice spills over into Israel's law, where the two words, *sad-dîq* and *miš-pāt*, occur. These two words are like Siamese twins, sometimes used interchangeably in the Old Testament. They do however have different shades of meaning and differing central tendencies. Any Christian discussion of justice must be derived from God as both just and right. If not, we will likely default to the idea's dominant at any one time in the wider world.*

Proverbs 18:5 (ESV) It is not good to be partial to the wicked or to deprive the righteous of justice.

Habakkuk 1:4 (ESV) So, the law is paralyzed, and justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround, the righteous, so justice goes forth perverted.

Job 34:17 (ESV) Shall one who hates justice govern? Will you condemn him who is righteous and mighty?

Psalms 37:30 (ESV) The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, and his tongue speaks justice.

Psalms 45:4 (ESV) In your majesty ride out victoriously for the cause of truth and meekness and righteousness; let your right hand teach you awesome deeds!

Ecclesiastes 5:8 (ESV) If you see in a province the oppression of the poor and the violation of justice and righteousness, do not be amazed at the matter, for the high official is watched by a higher, and there are yet higher ones over them.

Isaiah 5:7 (ESV) For the vineyard of the Lord of hosts is the house of Israel, and the men of Judah are his pleasant planting; and he looked for justice, but behold, bloodshed; for righteousness, but behold, an outcry!

Isaiah 51:5 (ESV) My righteousness draws near, my salvation has gone out, and my arms will judge the peoples; the coastlands hope for me, and for my arm they wait.

Isaiah 59:9 (ESV) Therefore, justice is far from us, and righteousness does not overtake us; we hope for light, and behold, darkness, and for brightness, but we walk in gloom.

Jeremiah 22:15 (ESV) Do you think you are a king because you compete in cedar? Did your father not eat and drink and do justice and righteousness? Then it was well with him.

Revelation 19:11 (ESV) Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war.



Genesis 18:19 (ESV) “For I have chosen him, that he may command his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing righteousness and justice, so that the Lord may bring to Abraham what he has promised him.”

1 Kings 10:9 (ESV) “Blessed be the Lord your God, who has delighted in you and set you on the throne of Israel! Because the Lord loved Israel forever, he has made you king, that you may execute justice and righteousness.”

Isaiah 9:7 (ESV) Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this.

Isaiah 11:4 (ESV) But with righteousness he shall judge the poor and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

Jeremiah 9:24 (ESV) “But let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the Lord.”

Jeremiah 11:20 (ESV) But, O Lord of hosts, who judges righteously, who tests the heart and the mind, let me see your vengeance upon them, for to you have I committed my cause.

Jeremiah 22:3 (ESV) Thus, says the Lord: Do justice and righteousness, and deliver from the hand of the oppressor him who has been robbed. And do no wrong or violence to the resident alien, the fatherless, and the widow, nor shed innocent blood in this place.

Ezekiel 45:9 (ESV) “Thus, says the Lord God: Enough, O princes of Israel! Put away violence and oppression and execute justice and righteousness. Cease your evictions of my people, declares the Lord God.”

Zephaniah 2:3 (ESV) Seek the Lord, all you humble of the land, who do his just commands; seek righteousness; seek humility; perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the anger of the Lord.



Luke 15:7 (ESV) Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.

Acts 17:31 (ESV) “Because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead.”

2 Chronicles 9:8 (ESV) “Blessed be the Lord your God, who has delighted in you and set you on his throne as king for the Lord your God! Because your God loved Israel and would establish them forever, he has made you king over them, that you may execute justice and righteousness.”

Ezekiel 16:52 (ESV) Bear your disgrace, you also, for you have intervened on behalf of your sisters. Because of your sins in which you acted more abominably than they, they are more in the right than you. So be ashamed, you also, and bear your disgrace, for you have made your sisters appear righteous.

Romans 6:19 (ESV) I am speaking in human terms, because of your natural limitations. For just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness leading to sanctification.
