



What is the Prayer Process?!

This comes through Prayer and His Plan (Obedience) done in our lives!

Below are areas I believe will help outline some of the areas of what I call the PRAYER PROCESS and HIS PLAN in OUR LIFE!

There are seven main components in the PRAYER and PRAISE PROCESS of a follower of Jesus. They are:

- ✓ Post
- ✓ Prepare
- ✓ Praise
- ✓ Presence
- ✓ Prayer
- ✓ Plan
- ✓ Profit

You will find in each of these areas what the word means, a general outline of the area, and verses that relate to the area.

Take your time, go through each area, pray, listen, and Jesus will speak, share, and instruct you in His will done on earth as it is in heaven for your life in ALL areas!

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1 - Post

Post, according to Merriam-Webster, is defined as:

Noun

- 1a : the place at which a soldier is stationed
- b: a station or task to which one is assigned
- c: the place at which a body of troops is stationed: CAMP
- 2a: an office or position to which a person is appointed
- 3a: TRADING POST, SETTLEMENT

What is your post?

It is a place and attitude of the heart, spirit, soul, and mind in Jesus where you can go to pray and praise Him!

This could be your desk, on your knees in your room, in the car, at church praising or in the prayer room, in your bible, hiking, eating, anywhere, anytime, ALL the time!

2 - Prepare

Prepare, according to Merriam-Webster, is defined as:

3a: to put together: COMPOUND (prepare a prescription)

b: to put into written form

Intransitive Verb - To get ready

How do you prepare?

The word tells us to set our heart to seek the LORD. In other words, it is a process that the LORD Jesus helps you to set your heart, your process, your place (post) to seek Jesus. Each person is different. For me, this is where I outline verses for the area, I am being led to pray through.
