- 75-120 Gallon Tank or 4x2x2 enclosure
- Beardie safe substrate
- UVB bulb for basking (10.0) Replace every
 6-12 months!
- Basking Lamp
- Food
- Food and water bowl
- Hidey house/ Logs or rocks for basking

Spot clean daily! Clean entire enclosure every 2-3 weeks.

Bearded Dragon Diet

Bearded Dragons are Omnivores which means their diet is made up of veggies and insects! You should feed your beardie 70% Veggies and 30% Insects. Beardies like fruits and veggies such as green leaf lettuce, Bell pepper, Carrot, blueberries, and Cucumber. When it comes to insects most beardie owners stick with crickets, Dubia roaches, and mealworms. You can also feed other types of insects such as super worms but not as often. You should feed your beardie veggies and insects every day or every other day depending on your dragon. You need to dust your insects with calcium as well as a multivitamin that contains Vitamin D3.

70% Veggies + 30% Insects= Happy Dragon!
