Guinea Pig Checklist:

- Cage (At least 7.5 sq feet)
- Hidey house/Tunnels (One per Pig)
- Water bottle, food bowl, hay rack
- Bedding
- Food
- Chew toys

Setting Up Your Guinea Pig Cage

Step 1: Build Cage!

Step 2: Add Bedding (Aspen Shavings, Paper based, Fleece.

Step 3: Add Hidey Huts and Chew toys!

Step 4: Add Hay rack (fill it up!)

Step 5: Add food bowl and water bottle

Step 6: Add your Piggies! Remember You must have at Least 2 guinea pigs!

Cleaning!

Clean Your Guinea Pig Cage Weekly
And spot clean every 1-2 days!

Guinea Pig Diet

Guinea Pigs are herbivores which means their diet is plant based. Guinea pigs have 2 essential food items that is Veggies and Hay. Veggies are the bulk of a piggy's diet. Some of my go-to veggies are Lettuce, Bell pepper, and cucumber. A guinea pig should eat 1 cup of veggies daily along with Hay which should be available 24/7. Guinea pig teeth are always growing so they need hay to grind down their teeth chew toys also help with this. Pellets are not essential but are great to make sure your piggies are eating. My favorite brand of guinea pig pellet is called Oxbow Guinea Pig Pellets.

1 cup veggies (per pig) + Unlimited hay + Pellets 1/8 cup (per pig) = Happy Piggie!
