Hamster Checklist!

- Cage (At least 600 sq inches)
- Wheel (6.5 inch for Dwarf and 10-12 inch for Syrian)
- Bedding (paper Based is best!)
- Water bottle
- Sand bath (Small Bowl of children's play sand)
- Hides/tunnels
- Chew toys
- Food

Setting Up Your Hamster Cage

STEP 1: ADD 6-8 INCHES OF A PAPER BASED BEDDING TO YOUR HAMSTER ENCLOSURE

STEP 2: ADD HIDEY HOUSES, TUNNELS!

STEP 3: ADD YOUR HAMSTER SAND BATH!

STEP 4: ADD YOUR WHEEL AND MAKE SURE IT CAN SPIN WITHOUT ANY INTERRUPTIONS.

STEP 5: ADD CHEW TOYS!

STEP 6: ADD WATER BOTTLE TO ENCLOSURE

STEP 7: SCATTER YOUR HAMSTERS FOOD AROUND THE ENCLOSURE

STEP 8: ADD YOUR HAMMY!

Hamster Diet:

Hamsters are Omnivores and need a good food mix. Sadly, none that are currently on the market are a complete mix for hamsters meaning most owners choose to mix their own. Here is my person favorite hamster seed mix but I encourage you to do your own research on your hamster's diet.

Mix 50% Higgins Sunburst Hamster food + 50% Mazrui Rat and mouse pellets = The perfect Hamster food!

Feeding and Cleaning

Your Hamster should be fed 1-2 tablespoons every 1-2 days depending on how fast or slow your hammy eats! Scatter feeding is a great way to feed your hammy.

Your Hamster cage should be fully cleaned every 2 weeks, but spot cleaned every 2 days!
