- Tank (At least 20 gallons!)
- Heating pad with temperature control
- 2 hides (cold and warm hide)
- Water bowl and food bowl
- Tank décor
- Bedding (paper towels are best)
- Food
- Temperature gauge
- Reptile Moss

SETTING UP YOUR LEOPARD GECKO TANK

STEP 1: SET UP HEATING PAD UNDER THE TANK ON THE RIGHT SIDE (88-92 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT)

STEP 2: ADD BEDDING

STEP 3: ADD WARM HIDE TO RIGHT SIDE

STEP 4: ADD COOL HIDE TO LEFT SIDE

STEP 5: PLACE DAMP MOSS IN COOL HIDE

STEP 6: ADD DÉCOR

STEP 7: ADD WATER BOWL

STEP 8: MIST TANK WITH WATER FOR HUMIDITY (30%-40%)

Leopard Gecko Diet

Leopard Geckos are insectivores meaning their diet only consists of insects. Leopard Geckos eat many different types of insects, but their favorites are Dubia roaches, Crickets, and mealworms. They also enjoy super worms and wax worms as treats. Keeping live insects for feeding is easy but you need a secure container. You will also need a water source for the live insects. Feed your Geckos 2-4 times per week.

Live insects + Water = Happy Gecko!



You should clean your Leopard Gecko tank every 2 weeks. You should spot clean every time your Leopard Gecko goes to the bathroom.
