Parakeet Checklist:

- Large Cage that is horizontal with a square top.
- Water and food dishes
- Perches (made from wood is best)
- Toys
- Bird Bath
- Food

Best Toys for Parakeets

Toys are an important part of your bird's cage set up but there are important rules to follow so your parakeet doesn't get hurt. Avoid plastic perches and they hurt your bird's feet and bend easily. Never give woven or fabric toys to your parakeet.

Cleaning!

Clean your parakeet's cage very week or more.

Parakeet Diet

Parakeets are known for their love of seeds. Though Parakeets would love to only eat seeds this will cause malnutrition for your Parakeet. Your parakeet will need a pellet food for the bulk of their diet with some seeds. Parakeets need a variety in their diet such as fruits and vegetables for vitamins. Your parakeet will need Fruits and vegetables at least 4 times per week. Calcium is another important part of your bird's diet. For this a cuttle-bone is best. As for treats parakeets love millet but should only consume 2 inches per day.

Pellets + Fresh Fruits and Veggies + seeds= Happy Parakeet.
