

Read through the following verses

Mark 1:40-42

And a leper came to Jesus, beseeching Him and falling on his knees before Him, and saying, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed.

Ask God these questions, and journal what thoughts come to mind. Underline any that really stick out to you. Remember, God's words will align with scripture and will edify, exhort, or comfort you. "There is no condemnation for those who are in Jesus Christ" (Rom 8:1)
