Who Am I?

- I am the salt of the earth (Matthew 5:13).
- I am the light of the world (Matthew 5:14).
- I am a child of God (John 1:12).
- I am part of the true vine, a branch of Christ's life (John 15:1, 5).
- I am Christ's friend (John 15:15).
- I am chosen and appointed by Christ to go and produce lasting fruit (John 15:16).
- I am free from the power of sin and have become a slave to righteous living (Romans 6:18).
- I am a slave to God (Romans 6:22).
- I am a child of God, for His Spirit leads me and I have been adopted into His family (Romans 8:14, 15; Galatians 3:26; 4:6).
- I am a joint heir with Christ, sharing in His glory (Romans 8:17).
- I am God's temple, and His Spirit lives in me (1 Corinthians 3:16; 6:19).
- I am united with the Lord and am one with Him in spirit (1 Corinthians 6:17).
- I am a member of Christ's body (1 Corinthians 12:27; Ephesians 5:30).
- I am a new person; the old life is gone and a new life has begun (2 Corinthians 5:17).
- I am reconciled to God, and He has given me this ministry of restoring relationships to Him (2 Corinthians 5:18, 19).
- I am a child of God through faith, and I am one with Christ (Galatians 3:26, 28).
- I am God's heir because I am His child (Galatians 4:6, 7).
- I am a saint, set apart as God's holy person (1 Corinthians 1:2; Ephesians 1:1; Philippians 1:1; Colossians 1:2).

- I am God's masterpiece, created anew in Christ so I can do the good things He planned for me (Ephesians 2:10).
- I am a fellow citizen with all of God's holy people and a member of His family (Ephesians 2:19).
- I am a prisoner for serving the Lord (Ephesians 3:1; 4:1).
- I am righteous and holy (Ephesians 4:24).
- I am a citizen of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives (Philippians 3:20; Ephesians 2:6).
- I am hidden with Christ in God (Colossians 3:3).
- I am an expression of the life of Christ, for He is my life (Colossians 3:4).
- I am chosen by God, holy and dearly loved (Colossians 3:12; 1 Thessalonians 1:4).
- I am a child of the light and of the day (1 Thessalonians 5:5).
- I am a holy partner in a heavenly calling (Hebrews 3:1).
- I am a faithful partner with Christ (Hebrews 3:14).
- I am one of God's living stones, being built into His spiritual temple (1 Peter 2:5).
- I am a member of a chosen people, a royal priest, a holy nation, and God's very own possession (1 Peter 2:9, 10).
- I am a foreigner and a temporary resident in this world (1 Peter 2:11).
- I am an enemy of the devil, who prowls around like a roaring lion (1 Peter 5:8).
- I am a child of God, and when Christ is revealed, I will be like Him (1 John 3:1, 2).
- I am born of God, and the evil one cannot touch me (1 John 5:18).
- I am what I am only by the grace of God (1 Corinthians 15:10).

- I have been made right in God's sight by faith and have peace with Him (Romans 5:1).
- I died with Christ and am no longer a slave to sin (Romans 6:1-6).
- I am free from any condemnation (Romans 8:1).

- I have been united with Christ Jesus by God Himself (1 Corinthians 1:30).
- I have received God's Spirit so I can know the wonderful things God has freely given me (1 Corinthians 2:12).
- I have the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16).
- I have been bought with a high price; I do not belong to myself but to God (1 Corinthians 6:19, 20).
- I have been identified as God's own, anointed and sealed by Him, and given the Holy Spirit as a guarantee (2 Corinthians 1:21, 22; Ephesians 1:13, 14).
- I no longer live for myself but for Christ, who died and was raised for me (2 Corinthians 5:14, 15).
- I have been made right with God through Christ (2 Corinthians 5:21).
- I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me (Galatians 2:20).
- I have been blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms (Ephesians 1:3).
- I was chosen in Christ before the world began to be holy and without fault in His eyes (Ephesians 1:4).
- I was predestined to be adopted into God's own family (Ephesians 1:5).
- I have been purchased with the blood of Christ and my sins are forgiven through His rich grace (Ephesians 1:7, 8).
- I have been given life together with Christ (Ephesians 2:5).
- I have been raised up and seated with Christ in the heavenly realms (Ephesians 2:6).
- I have been given the right to come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit (Ephesians 2:18).
- I can come fearlessly into God's presence with freedom and confidence (Ephesians 3:12).
- I have been rescued from the kingdom of darkness and transferred into the Kingdom of God's dear Son (Colossians 1:13).
- I have been purchased for freedom and my sins are forgiven; the record of charges against me was canceled (Colossians 1:14; 2:14).
- Christ Himself lives in me (Colossians 1:27).

- I am deeply rooted in Christ and my life is being built on Him (Colossians 2:7).
- I am complete through my union with Christ (Colossians 2:10).
- I have been spiritually circumcised by a spiritual procedure (Colossians 2:11).
- I have been buried and raised to new life with Christ (Colossians 2:12, 13).
- I died with Christ and have been raised to new life; my real life is hidden with Christ in God, and Christ is my life (Colossians 3:1-4).
- I have been given a spirit of power, love, and self-discipline (2 Timothy 1:7).
- I have been saved and called to a holy life through God's own action (2 Timothy 1:9; Titus 3:5).
- I am not someone Christ is ashamed to call a brother, for we have the same Father (Hebrews 2:11).
- I can come boldly to the throne of our gracious God to receive His mercy and grace in my time of need (Hebrews 4:16).
- I have been given great and precious promises that allow me to share in the divine nature (2 Peter 1:4).
