

**Harvey's Heroes Dog Rescue**  
**Foster Agreement**

1. Foster Caregiver agrees to let HHDR inspect premises where the animal is being kept at any time to ascertain and satisfy itself that the animal is well cared for.
  
2. Foster Caregiver agrees to provide adequate food, water, shelter and kind treatment for said animal at all times. The Foster Caregiver will not leave the dog unattended in the yard, even if it is fenced. The dog must be kept inside at night.
  
3. HHDR agrees to provide adequate veterinary care, to include altering, vaccines, heartworm testing and preventatives. This will be done at one of the veterinary clinics that they have a relationship with.
  
4. Foster Caregiver agrees to notify HHDR as to any behavioral or health problems of the animal. HHDR reserves the exclusive right to determine the proper course of action to take upon such notification.
  
5. Foster Caregiver must notify HHDR of any injury or health problems with the dog. HHDR has special agreements with rescue-friendly vets in the area and appointments must be made by a representative of HHDR. HHDR will pay for medically necessary treatments at the veterinarian clinics that have provided special pricing. If a Foster Caregiver takes a dog to a vet without contacting HHDR first, or refuses to use one of our rescue friendly vets, then they will be held responsible for payment of any treatment provided.
  
6. Foster Caregiver will notify HHDR in the event any change occurs in the address or telephone number listed below. Foster Caregiver understands and acknowledges that he/she does not have any right or authority to keep the foster animal or place foster animal in other homes or place with other individuals unless permission is given in writing by HHDR.
  
7. Foster Caregiver agrees that accidental animal bites or other injuries to humans and other animals do occur, and agrees to hold harmless and indemnify HHDR, from any claim or suit filed by anyone as a result of such an incident. In addition, HHDR will not be responsible if animal should damage or destroy property belonging to Foster Caregiver or Foster Caregiver's neighbors, or shall transfer any disease or internal or external parasites to other animals belonging to Foster Caregiver.

8. Foster Caregiver will not leave animal with someone else without notifying HHDR. Foster Caregiver shall not surrender the dog to any animal shelter or another rescue.

9. In regards to pets that have gone through or will be going through heartworm treatment, the Foster Caregiver agrees to limiting exercise to 3-4 daily, short walks on a leash and limit all play. If foster dog becomes lethargic, starts to cough, or becomes overly stimulated, it is imperative for the Foster Caregiver to contact HHDR immediately.
