CONGRATULATIONS TO THE 2025 TEXAS TRAPSHOOTERS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

Andrew Fryman



Drew started shooting in Kentucky in 2001. Quickly winning at the Kentucky state shoot with a JR title in handicap as well as HOA JR, and HAA JR, making the Kentucky state team as a JR in 2003.

In 2018, Drew made the TTA State second team, then made the same team in 2019,2020, 2024 while making the first team in 2023 and 2025. The trophy list includes states such as Kentucky, Oklahoma as the out of state singles AA champ. Kansas where he was the 2019 out of state runner up in handicap. Missouri


where he was Class AA doubles nonresident along with AA singles in the Patrick Hopson singles, and 2023 nonresident handicap. Arizona where he was 5th nonresident handicap. Many trophies from the Southwest Grand where he was 4th place in handicap. Drew has run a 200 in singles at Tucson and at Fort Worth, he has also run a 100 in doubles at Fort Worth. One target has kept him from the Grand Slam, but it is just a matter of time before this happens. Drew was an integral part of getting Waco throwing targets again, serving on their board and trap chairman. Drew served Zone IV as an officer, sets targets at shoots, squads and classifies shooters. Drew played a major role in the growth of Zone IV, Waco, and the TTA as 2nd and 1st Vice-President. At the 2022 Grand American, Drew finally trophied after many years, he took third in the NRA singles. Then winning the 27-yard handicap in 2024.

Ron started shooting at the age of 14 in Kansas and after graduating served in the United States Air Force for 36 years. During his shooting career Ron has registered 55,000 singles, 50,025 handicap, and 42,400 doubles targets. Ron has won trophies at TTA Zone Shoots as well as state shoots here in Texas, Kansas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Arkansas, Southwest Grand, the Autumn Grand, as well as the Grand American starting in 2010 as the White Flyer 2700 Tar-





get Class B High Overall. Here in Texas, there has not been a task Ron would not take on. Ron has served as President of Fort Worth, 4 years as Zone IV President, 2nd and 1st Vice-Presidents of the TTA as well as President of the TTA with 6 years on the Hall of Fame committee and two years of that being the chairman, as well as 3 years as the state's first alternate delegate. He has also been a target setter at the Grand American, the Southwest Grand, our state shoot, as Zone Shoots.


During all the years Ron has served the TTA, he has made the Texas State Team as a Veteran twice, with one of those years being the captain.



Shooters attending the Texas State Shoot for five years or multiple of five years will be awarded the appropriate anniversary pin by the TTA Secretary upon request. Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight in events or sub-events of that length **for the first time** will be awarded a TTA 100 or TTA 200 straight pin from the Secretary, **for State Events only**.

CLASSIFICATION & HANDICAPPING

The Handicap Committee will be Billy Hopson. (Note: You must have an up to date Average Card)

CLASSIFICATION WILL BE BASED ON THE HIGHEST OF: LAST 2 YEAR'S AVERAGE—THIS YEAR'S AVERAGE—KNOWN ABILITY

Any shooter who has registered less than 1000 16 yard, 1000 Handicap and 500 Doubles for the current year and previous 2 years combined will be required to shoot penalty class and yardage as listed below. Preliminary day's targets (Events 1, 2 and 3) will apply to minimum target requirements.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify all shooters any time during the shoot. The ATA Rules will govern all points that are not otherwise provided herein. If you win your class in any event or earn yardage in any handicap, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to report such changes to Classification AND Squadding. Winners and ties for winner, move up in class starting with event 4 & 6.

PRE-SQUAD PROCEDURE

We will be using Presquad.com for the 2025 Texas State Shoot. The fee will be \$5.00 per person regardless of the number of events you presquad for. The presquad fees will be collected at the time you use presquad.

The first 10 squads for Sunday's handicap are being held for shooters that are traveling over 300 miles to accommodate your trip home. Please contact Sandra McAllister (mcallister.sm55@gmail.com) ASAP if you need an early squad for Sunday's handicap.

The first 10 squads for HOF Doubles (Event 12) on Friday are being held for shooters that are attending the HOF reception and need time to prepare. Please contact Sandra McAllister (mcallister.sm@gmail.com) ASAP if you need an early squad.

If you presquad and/or your yardage changes before or during the shoot, check with squadding to see if your handicap squad is still within the rules. Please be aware that penalty yardage and class will apply at this shoot and presquad accordingly.

Pre-squadding for the shoot will be open from April 12th—June 28th.

Avoid Squadding Lines

Pre-Register at PreSquad.com for the Texas State Shoot July 1st—6th There will be a \$5 charge paid for by the shooter and registration is open from April 12th—June 28th

If you withdraw from an event, please contact Sandra McAllister (mcallister.sm55@gmail.com) and withdraw to open the squad/post for another shooter.

RULES GOVERNING THIS TOURNAMENT

- 1. All contestants will be eligible for trophies.
- 2. All options are open to anyone who pays the option fees. All options are paid on a percentage basis unless otherwise stated.
- 3. A cashier's sheet showing all shooters playing the money will be posted for all events. All option monies after the shoot will be mailed. Pay off sheet will be included with checks.
- 4. Management will not be responsible for errors in scores after the options have been posted. Shooters should use score board to check their scores and notify shoot management immediately if a discrepancy is noticed. SCORES BECOME FINAL TWO (2) HOURS AFTER THE CONCLU-SION OF THE EVENT. PAYOFFS: purse, option, and added money will start at 1 PM the day following the events.
- 5. In all events, squadding will be done at the squadders discretion.
- 6. We suggest you use prequad.com for the entire program. Changes in the purses or options will be permitted ONLY if done the day before the event. There will be a \$10 per entry fee assessed per event change. The Grievance Committee must authorize any exceptions.
- 7. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules. They may be checked upon request of the shooters, but will not be reset unless they become illegal or are markedly different from the trap settings.
- 8. TTA Officials reserve the right to refuse the entry of, or to disqualify any shooter who, in its opinion is interfering with the harmony of the tournament.
- 9. TTA Officials reserve the right to postpone, change, or cancel any event due to foul weather or other causes, and to change the time for starting any events.
- 10. Reloads will be permitted at this tournament. Shoot Management, ATA official(s) or any contestant may challenge the load of any other contestant. Management shall obtain a shell from the challenged and after examination, if it is found the contestant violated the rules, they may be disqualified and the incident reported to the officials of the ATA.
- 11. It is an error if the referee fails to properly mark the results of any shooter in the section of the score sheet where the results should have been recorded. In such cases it is the duty of the contestant to have any error corrected before he has fired the first shot at the succeeding position, or in the case of the last post, before the shooter leaves the trap. Otherwise, the shooter shall be held to the score as recorded.
- 12. If you want your empties, put them in your pocket after firing. No picking up of empties is allowed.
- 13. Shells, in standard loads, will be for sale on the grounds @ current market prices.
- 14. Contestants will forfeit should they not be on hand for a shoot-off. For all events except the last event of each day, a trophy list will be posted by the options so you can check for your name. Shoot-offs will begin as soon as possible after the last event of the day. There will be a 1st (15 Min), 2nd (10 Min), and final 3rd (5 Min) call. Shoot-off personnel will not attempt to find shooters for shoot-offs.
- 15. We are not responsible in the event of accident, theft or injury.
- 16. Shoot Offs: All ties in Handicap for place will be shot off daily, regardless of a yardage increase or not. All ties in Singles and Doubles will be carried forward to the next like event.
- 17. All events on Tuesday are club events. Please direct questions about these events to club management.
- 18. No shooter will be able to make up more than two sub-events on the practice trap, if the shooter missed their squad. A shooter unable to join their squad before the squad has started firing on the first station of the third sub-event must be re-squad and pay a \$25 re-squading fee. The shooter will be squadded on the same bank that the shooter would have originally shot on. All make-ups for either missed squads or gun repairs must report to the practice trap are within 30 minutes of the last squad taking the line for that event.
- 19. No squad will delay a start more than three (3) minutes, if there are squad members absent. At the expiration of three (3) minutes, the squad will be started. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 20. If you withdraw from an event or miss an event and decide to re-enter you will be placed back on the same bank that you would have originally shot on.
- 21. Classification and Squadding will be open Monday, June 30, 2025 from 1-5 PM

RULES GOVERNING THIS TOURNAMENT (cont....)

- 24. Squadding and Cashier's windows will close 5 PM daily.
- 25. Winners must pick up trophies in person. Trophies not picked up will be mailed at recipient's expense, freight collected.
- 26. All special category shooters must declare their special category at the time of their entry in the shoot. Without such declaration at the time of their entry the shooter will not be allowed to compete for the applicable special category trophies. No exceptions allowed.
- 27. High All Around (Events 13, 14 & 15) and High Over All (Events 4 thru 15) scores will be posted on the club bulletin board within 30 minutes after the completion of event 15. It is the shooters responsibility to check the posted leader board for accuracy.
- 28. The Texas Trapshooters Association reserves the right to change, alter or modify this program in whole or in part.
- 29. No shooter may win more than one trophy, in any one event except for Zone 5 man team, husband & wife, parent & child, and club trophies.
- 30. Military personnel, without a bona fide Texas residence, are not eligible for Resident State Championship Trophies, but may compete for Open/Category Non-Resident Trophies.
- 31. Any type of abuse of trap personnel or shoot personnel will not be tolerated. Any problems shooters may encounter should be referred to the line referee and grievance committee.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY ENTRY AND SHOOTING PROCEDURE

- 1. Take your **average card** to classification upon your arrival, **with all scores included and all averages figured**. You are subject to penalties for shooting in the wrong classification or on the wrong yardage, even if your card is so marked. It shall be the Shooter's Responsibility to inform the handicap committee as to their eligibility. If you have pre-squadded, you will have an entry form waiting for you. Once you are classified, then you may proceed to the cashiers window. If you did not pre-squadd, go to Squadding next.
- 2. Squad for all events at one time. This will help you when we make up squad sheets for the morning events, and will expedite the entry process.
- 3. Next move to the cashier's window. The cashier will accept no counter checks or second party checks. Checks will be accepted for the amount of shooting fees only. No exceptions. All payments must be in US Dollars, no credit cards accepted.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR PURSE AND AWARD

The \$20 fee for this award is a 50% tax-deductible donation to the Hall of Fame. This donation provides support to our new museum and to the many worthy projects undertaken by the Hall of Fame. All donors will qualify for the Hall of Fame Award. Your entry card shows this contribution and is your receipt. The Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Monies will be paid out in three Lewis Classes, 60/40 high gun each class. The high score in the event will receive a Shamrock Leathers specially crafted oak and leather wall clock suitably engraved. NOTE: Any ties will be resolved by shoot management's discretion.





Important Announcement About Fort Worth Trap and Skeet



Contrary to the rumors of our demise, we are still in business and will continue to be. What has happened? Back in 1974 the FWTS BOD sold 12-14 acres to our north. Sadly, they knew of potential shot-fall problems, but only put a 35-year shot-fall easement on the land. That expired and there was no BOD knowledge of this until the land was inherited and we were asked if we could help with deed restrictions in late 2024. Of course, we would help in any way we could, and we asked if we could put the shot fall easement back in place, the answer was no. Not having any issues with the neighbor and the club we started to plan.

In November of 2024, the property to the north sold. The deed restrictions were not lifted, but they did not apply to commercial. Work started in December of 24 and January of 25 to build a flex space warehouse complex. Our BOD started to work on a solution, and we voted to install a shot screen across all our fields 85-90 yards out from the 16-yard line. This is a must to stay where we are right now, and we have engaged a powerful commercial broker to assist us in finding new ground and procuring a sale of our highly valuable piece of property.

We are fortunate to own the land we are on right now and will use that money to find a new location, construct and even bigger and better location to host more people and larger shoots. This not only benefits, the members of FWTS. This helps keep our sport alive in Zone IV and throughout the state.

The goal is for the curtain to be installed by the end of August 2025 and no later than September. The 19th annual Bair Hatcher will be our first ATA shoot on it, and I hope you will attend. We are funding this project with donations and will take them from anywhere. I just wanted to assure you that FWTS is not going away and we will be there for the TTA shooters.
