Thanks for attending the 2025 Oklahoma State Trap Shoot.

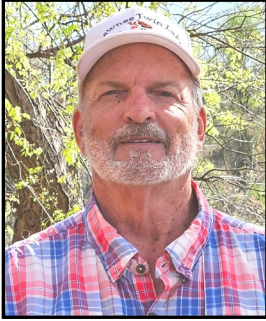

2025 Hall of Fame Inductees

The OTSA Board of Directors voted to induct to the Oklahoma Trapshooting Hall of Fame:

Jim Black



I was introduced to trapshooting in 1973 by Donald Miller, a co-worker, who was avid trapshooter and hunter. We shot at the FAA Gun Club on the North side of Will Rogers Airport. I also shot at the Capital City and Weatherford Gun Clubs.

In the late 1970s my wife and I started a family and I quit trapshooting to raise the kids, In 1995 I started shooting again and met an old friend, Jess Pemberton, and we have shot together for many years. I was elected to the OTA board of directors on two different elections, once each

under Doc Koper and Ron Wilson. Under Ron Wilson, the Board asked Tim Deister, Tim McCann and myself to run the club until a manager could be found, which took approximately 1 year. The 3 of us managed the OTA including the State Shoot, monthly shoots, skeet shoots and winter shooting.

I shot in the Grand American 4 times in Vandalia, 1 time in Sparta and the Southwestern Grand in San Antonio. At the 2005 Grand American, I broke 200 straight to reach the Singles Championships shoot-off, which began during a pouring rain at night.

In 2006 I began shooting at Shawnee Gun Club and have been on their Board 6 times and 3 times as President. At Shawnee Gun Club, we have the Bethel Acres FFA team and I do my best to help teach these young shooters, and really enjoy helping them. I have also worked closely with the Oklahoma Youth Expo and Bray Havens to setup preliminary shoots for their State Shoot.

During my career I have shot: 3 - 200 straights; 37 - 100 straights; and won 179 ATA registered contests. Most memorable wins include the: 1995 Oklahoma State Preliminary Handicap Champion and B Class High Overall; 1996 Oklahoma State AA Singles Champion and Southwestern Zone Budweiser Handicap Mid Yardage Champion; 2000 Oklahoma State Preliminary Class C Champion; 2008 Oklahoma State Handicap Champion; 2010 Oklahoma State Class A Singles Champion; 2012 Oklahoma State Class AA Singles Champion (tie); and 2014 Oklahoma State Class AA Singles (tie).

One of my most memorable shoots included a shoot-off for a Singles Championship against Karl Tomanka (OTA Hall of Fame member). We both ran 200, and were tied in the shoot-off going into the last post, I shot 1st and my wad broke the target as verified by Karl Tomanka and the score keeper, Karl missed the next and I ran the trap winning the shoot-off and the singles championship.

ENTRY INFORMATION

This printed program governs the 2025 Oklahoma State Shoot. Interpretations of the program are made by OTSA officials & their decisions are final. ATA rules are strictly enforced. An event begins immediately after the previous event so if you schedule late in one event & early in the next, you may miss your squad. The OTSA reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event or limit entries to said event. OTSA may refuse any entrant.

The OTSA starts giving 126th Oklahoma State Shoot pins when shooters cashier for Event 4. The first 150 shooters will receive a pin.

The cashier, squadding, & classification windows opens each tournament day at 8:00am and closes at 4:00pm, except Sunday. Sunday, June 2 opening and closing times are 9:00 AM and 1:00pm

All single & handicap events are shot 5 targets per post, 50 targets per trap. Doubles events are 50 targets per trap, 5 pair per post.

BANKS WILL BE ROTATED EACH DAY. There is a bank drawing each morning. Bank assignments are posted daily no later than 8:45am in the club house. Shoot management reserves the right to reassign banks and/or re-squad shooters at any time to facilitate the completion of an event.

FEES

Daily fees of \$4.00 each for the OTSA and ATA are collected each tournament day.

PRACTICE TRAPS

Practice starts Tuesday, May 31st at 9:00am. All other days the practice trap opens at 8:00am. Practice traps may be closed if needed for events. Practice targets are \$8.00 for 25 targets, & can be purchased at the cashiers window.

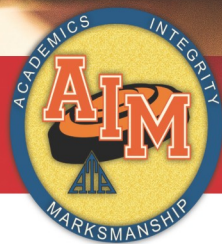

ENTRY

Classification opens daily at 8:00 AM beginning Tuesday, May 27th. Come early & avoid the rush. **Shooters who enter & pay for an event may go back & enter options later so long as that event has not started.**

CHECKS, PAYMENTS & OVERPAYMENTS

Anyone who presents a check for fees & targets that is returned for insufficient funds or for other causes may not compete in any registered event until full payment has been made to the club to which it was presented. Any such checks shall have the name & address of the shooter issuing the check reported to the ATA. No second party checks are accepted.

Sub-Junior & Junior shooters may shoot for \$36.00 per event, plus daily fees. If options are played, the shooter pays regular prices.

NO RE-SQUADDING OR WITHDRAWING AFTER EVENT STARTS.

SHELLS

Shooters may furnish their own shells, including reloads. If you want your empties, put them in your pocket. Do not pick up empties from the ground. Shell specifications as to allowable shot size, shot load, & speed are governed by ATA Rules.

TARGETS

Targets are White Flyer orange dome, & are set according to ATA Rules.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARDS

The \$20 fee for this award in the Oklahoma State Handicap Championship, Sunday, June 1 is a tax-deductible donation to the Hall of Fame.

The purpose of this donation is to further the Hall of Fame expansion & worthy projects such as the Youth Trapshooting Program. All donors will qualify for the Hall of Fame Awards. Your entry card shows this contribution and is your receipt. The Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Monies are paid out in three Lewis Classes. 60/40 high gun each class. Again, the \$20 fee is a contribution & in turn you will be eligible for Hall of Fame Contributor Awards, which are a thank you for the contribution & is in no way to be considered a purse.

CLASSIFICATION

Classification is based on this year's average, last year's average or the last 500 targets, whichever is highest. Any shooter who has registered less than 500 Singles, 500 handicap or 300 doubles for the current or previous year must shoot penalty yardage & classification

Once a category declaration is made by either a shooter or shoot management, the **declaration is final & cannot be changed**. There shall be no exception to this rule.

CLASS ADVANCE RULES

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the classification of any shooter at any time. High scores in Class regardless of category are advanced 1 class. If a shooter earns yardage, it is the shooter's responsibility to see that their average card is properly punched. **Class advances begin with Events 4 & 5.**

Returned unsold tickets will be available for purchase at the 2025 Grand American. Raffle tickets/entries will not be available once all tickets are sold. The recipient will receive a W-2G form from the ATA, and will be responsible for any federal, state, and local income taxes.

SHOOT OFFS

All ties in singles and doubles during preliminary events are carried over by sub-event to the next like event of the shoot except for handicap events. Contestants will receive three calls for shoot offs. Anyone who does not answer a call for shoot offs will forfeit their right to any prize or trophy. All singles & handicap shoot offs are on a 25-target basis & doubles are on a 10-pair basis. HOA & HAA shoot offs are shot as 20 Singles, 10 Handicap, & 5 pair of Doubles. Ties for all trophies in all Handicap events are shot off daily.

PAYOFFS

Payoffs start at noon the following day for Tuesday through Friday's events. Any error in posted scores have to be brought to management's attention immediately following posting of the scores. Once payoffs have started, there are no changes made in the option calculations. All payoffs for Saturday & Sunday's events are mailed. Checks are mailed after June 30, 2025. .

SPECIAL EVENT

A Special Event is held associated with the 2025 Oklahoma State Championship Handicap. Auction will occur on Saturday, May 31st in the club house at 7:00 PM at the Saturday Nite BBQ Bar No phone entries.

STATE MEETING

The Oklahoma State Trap & Skeet Association Annual Meeting is held Sunday morning June 1st at 8:00am. Oklahoma State Teams, Hall of Fame Inductees, & all elections are held at the meeting.

CAMPING

Camping spaces with electric & water hook-ups are available by paid reservation only. For reservation information, contact Tim Mount (405) 317-8833 or jitter226@cox.net. Fee is \$150 for the entire shoot year. Your space is not guaranteed until payment is made. Payment needs to be made by April 1, 2023 to guarantee your reservation.

VENDORS

WATCH FOR YOUR SQUAD

The first event of the day starts at the time listed in the program. Your squad **will not wait more than three minutes** for you to take your post. If you are not present within the allotted time, your name is scratched, your squad will proceed without you. You will have to shoot make-up if you arrive before the end of the first 50 targets, or re-squad otherwise. **You will not be paged.**

BLOCKING POSTS AND SQUADS

The computer program used for the State Shoot was developed to reserve posts only for short time periods, primarily to allow shooters in line to squad together. Also, blocked posts have no names attached to them. Management **will not** guarantee blocked positions for any shooter. **ALL POSITIONS BLOCKED THE PREVIOUS DAY ARE RELEASED AT 9 AM.**

HIGH ALL-AROUND AND HIGH OVERALL

Class High All-Around is figured on Championship Singles classification as of Event #12. Class High Overall is figured on Singles classification for Event #4.


TROPHIES

All Trophies must be awarded by the Trophy Committee. No trophies may be taken by a winner until signed for with the Trophy Committee. Trophies will not be shipped. Contestants can win only one trophy in each event. Please pick-up trophies daily to avoid long lines on Sunday.

100 & 200 STRAIGHT PINS

100 & 200 (perfect) straight pins were designed exclusively for the state shoot, & will be awarded in each discipline. These pins will not be awarded at other shoots, & only one pin is presented to successful shooters for each discipline. There are no carry-overs.

ATA RULES WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE WINNERS OF ALL TROPHIES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER TROPHIES ARE FURNISHED BY OTSA OR ATA. ATA RULES REGARDING "FALL BACKS" ARE USED TO DETERMINE ALL WINNERS.

It is the responsibility of shooters in special categories to make sure their entry sheet is correctly marked at the classification desk. Special category shooters may win only one trophy per event. A shooter may not change categories after they have shot the first event.

PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY

- 1.Go to desk of the Handicap & Classification Committee to be classified.
- 2.Go to squadding station to chose squads & posts for chosen events.
- 3.Go to Cashier's window to pay entry.

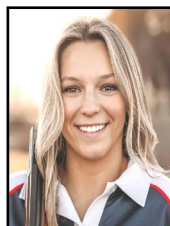

Verlin “Doc” Koper:

60 Years of Excellence at the Oklahoma State Trap Shoot



The 2025 Oklahoma State Trap Shoot marks Verlin “Doc” Koper’s 60th consecutive year of participation in the event. Over the years, he has registered more than 366,000 trap targets while competing in states across the country, from Florida to Washington and Maine to Arizona.

Doc’s impressive accomplishments include serving as president of the Oklahoma Trapshooters Association (now the OTSA) twice and as a member of the Board of Directors multiple times. He has claimed the title of Oklahoma State Champion in singles, doubles, handicap, and high all-around. Additionally, he has been named to numerous Oklahoma State teams and has twice earned a spot on the prestigious ATA All-American team.

Many have wondered about the origins of his nickname, “Doc.” During his pursuit of a doctorate in mathematics, past ATA president Hill Sailor frequently asked if he was a doctor. For years, the answer was no—until one day, it became yes. From that moment on, Sailor called him “Doc,” and the name stuck, first within the trapshooting community and eventually beyond.

Outside of trapshooting, Doc has been a highly skilled wing-shooter. At one point, he maintained an impressive 80% hit rate with his .410 Browning Superposed in a single year. His love of the outdoors extended to hunting upland game across Oklahoma, Arizona, New Mexico, Montana, Idaho, Kansas, Nebraska, and South Dakota.

With six decades of dedication to the sport, Verlin “Doc” Koper’s legacy in Oklahoma trapshooting is undeniable, and his contributions continue to inspire generations of shooters.

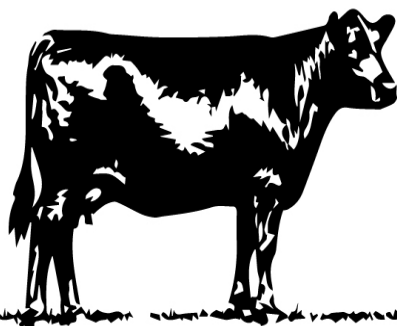

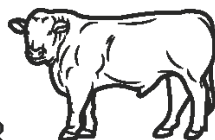
