# Garland Sears 2021 Hall of Fame

Garland Sears has literally spent his entire life around shooting sports, especially trap shooting. From playing in the rocks as a toddler at the old club in



OKC while his dad, Gene Sears, was shooting, to shooting his first registered targets at age 13, Garland has been a long-time fixture in the trap community. In addition to trap shooting, Garland has worked for the family business, Gene Sears Supply Company, since he was a kid. Garland started at a young age prepping hulls for his dad to

reload and then boxing loaded shells with his mom (Betty). Whether Garland was in the store or mining lead across the country, he's always been a significant part of the family business. Garland has had many great trap shooting memories and accomplishments throughout his career. His most memorable shooting year was 1968. That was the year Garland earned his 27-yard punch, shot his first 200 straight, and won the Parent-Child Championship with his dad shooting a 394x400. In 1971, Garland and Gene lost the Parent-Child event by one target. One of his last wins in Oklahoma was the Class A State Championship Doubles in the late 2000's. Garland has great memories of shooting mainly throughout the Southwest Zone, attending numerous Grand America events in Vandalia, OH in the late 60's and early

70's. Whether shooting or reclaiming lead, Garland always enjoyed coming back to OTA. Away from trap shooting and the store, Garland enjoys spending time with his family and fishing and hunting on the farm that his grandparent's homesteaded west of El Reno. Garland has been a longtime supporter of trap shooting from many different aspects; shooter, reclaiming lead, and retailer.



#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

This printed program will govern our 2022 Oklahoma State Shoot. Interpretation of the program will be made by OTSA officials and their decision will be final. ATA rules will be strictly enforced. An event will begin immediately following the previous event so if you schedule late in one event and early in the next, you may miss your squad. The OTSA reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event or limit entries to said event. OTSA may refuse any entrant

The OTSA will be giving 123nd Oklahoma State Shoot pins when you cashier for Event 4.

The cashier, squadding, and classification windows will open each tournament day at 8:00am and will close at 4:00pm. Closing time on Sunday, June 5, 2022 will be at 1:00pm

All single and handicap events will be shot 5 targets per post, 50 targets per trap. Doubles events will be 50 targets per trap, 5 pair per post.

**BANKS WILL BE ROTATED EACH DAY**. There will be a bank drawing each morning. Bank assignments will be posted daily no later than 8:45am in the club house. Shoot management reserves the right to reassign banks and/or resquad shooters at any time to facilitate the completion of an event.

#### PRACTICE TRAPS

Practice starts Tuesday, May 31st at 9:00am. All other days the practice trap will open at 8:00am. Practice traps may be closed if needed for events. Practice targets are \$8.00 for 25 targets.

#### MAKE-UP TRAPS SHALL BE LIMITED TO 50 TARGETS

#### **FNTRY**

Classification will open on Tuesday, May 31<sup>st</sup> at 8:00am. Come early and avoid the rush. (If a shooter has entered and paid for an event, he may go back and enter options later so long as that event has not started.)

#### **CHECKS, PAYMENTS & OVERPAYMENTS**

Anyone who presents a check at any shoot for fees and targets that is returned for insufficient funds or for other causes may not compete in any registered shoot until full payment has been made to the individual or club to which it was presented. Clubs receiving such check shall report the name and address of the shooter issuing the check to the ATA. No second party checks will be accepted.

Sub-Junior and Junior shooters may shoot for \$30.00 per event, plus fees, unless options are played. In such cases, the shooter pays regular prices.

# NO RE-SQUADDING OR WITHDRAWING AFTER EVENT STARTS.

#### SHELLS

Shooters may furnish their own shells, including reloads. If you want your empties, put them in your pocket. Do not pick up empties from the ground. Shell specifications will be governed by ATA rules.

#### **TARGETS**

Targets will be White Flyer orange dome, and will be set according to ATA Rules.

#### HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARDS

The \$20 fee for this award is a tax-deductible donation to the Hall of Fame. The purpose of this donation is to further the Hall of Fame expansion and worthy projects such as the Youth Trapshooting Program. All donors will qualify for the Hall of Fame Awards. Your entry card shows this contribution and is your receipt. The Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Monies will be paid out in three Lewis Classes. 60/40 high gun each class. Again the \$20 fee is a contribution and in turn you will be eligible for the Hall of Fame Contributor Awards, which are a thank you for the contribution and is in no way to be considered a purse.

#### CLASSIFICATION

Classification is based on this year's average, last year's average or the last 500 targets, whichever is highest. Any shooter who has registered less than 500 Singles, 500 handicap or 300 doubles for the current year or previous year will be required to shoot penalty yardage and classification.

#### CLASS ADVANCE RULES

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the classification of any shooter at any time. High scores in Class regardless of category will be advanced 1 class. If a shooter earns yardage, it is the shooter's responsibility to see that their average card is properly punched. Class advances will begin with Event 4.

#### **VENDORS**

All vendors are welcome. Please contact Ron Bliss for vendor reservations (405) 641-8979.

#### SHOOT OFFS

All ties will be carried over by sub-event to the next like event of the shoot except for handicap events. Contestants will receive three calls for shoot offs. Anyone who does not answer a call for shoot offs will forfeit their right to any prize or trophy. All singles and handicap shoot offs will be on a 25-target basis and doubles will be 10-pair. All singles carry-overs will be on a 25-target basis and doubles will be on a 50-target basis. HOA & HAA shoot offs will be shot as 20 Singles, 10 Handicap, & 5 pair of Doubles. Ties for all trophies in all Handicap events shall be shot off daily.

#### **PAYOFFS**

Payoffs will be made starting at noon the following day for Tuesday through Friday's events. Any error in posted scores have to be brought to management's attention immediately following the posting of the scores. Once payoffs have started, there will be no changes made in the option calculations. All payoffs for Saturday and Sunday's events will be mailed. Checks will be mailed by Tuesday, June 30, 2022. Payoff sheets mailed for Saturday & Sunday events only.

#### SPECIAL EVENT

A Special Event will be held associated with the 2022 Oklahoma State Championship Handicap. Auction will occur on Saturday, June 4th in the club house at 6:00pm. No phone entries

#### STATE MEETING

The Oklahoma State Trap and Skeet Association Annual Meeting will be held Sunday morning at 8:00am. Oklahoma State Teams, Hall of Fame Inductees, and all elections will be held at this meeting.

#### CAMPING

Electric and water camping spaces are available by paid reservation only. For reservation information, contact Ron Bliss (405) 641-8979 or countryequipment2@gmail.com. Fee is \$150 for entire shoot year. Your space is not guaranteed until payment is made. Payment needs to be made by April 1, 2022 to guarantee your reservation.

#### WATCH FOR YOUR SQUAD

The first event of the day will start at the time listed. Be on the grounds ahead of the time and watch for your squad. Your squad cannot wait more than three minutes for you to take your post. If you are not within the allotted time, your name will be scratched and your squad will proceed without you. You will not be paged.

#### **BLOCKING POSTS AND SQUADS**

The computer program used for the State Shoot was developed to reserve posts only for short time periods, primarily to allow shooters in line to squad together. Also, blocked posts have no names attached to them, and Management will not guarantee blocked positions for any shooter. ALL POSITIONS BLOCKED THE PREVIOUS DAY WILL BE RELEASED AT 9 AM.

#### HIGH ALL-AROUND AND HIGH OVERALL

Class High All-Around will be figured on your Championship Singles classification as of Event #12. Class High Overall will be figured on our Singles classification in Event #4.

#### **TROPHIES**

All Trophies must be awarded by the Trophy Committee. No trophies may be taken by a winner until signed for with the Trophy Committee. Trophies will not be shipped. Contestants can win only one trophy in each event. Please pick-up trophies daily to avoid Sunday's long delay.

ATA RULES WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE WINNERS OF ALL TROPHIES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER TROPHIES ARE FURNISHED BY OTSA OR ATA. ATA RULES REGARDING "FALL BACKS" WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE ALL WINNERS.


#### PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY
