


Dennis Patrick, President

Dennis Patrick 2020 Hall of Fame



Dennis Patrick first became aware of the Trap Shooting sport in 1973 as a youth working for A.T. Zachary. At the time Zachary had a trap club on the north side of Hwy 66 in El Reno, where Dennis set targets and loaded shells for him. 2016 Dennis started shooting trap again and registered targets in 2017. In 2018 he attended the Grand where he broke 99 to win 2nd place in a singles event. At the 2018 Arkansas State Shoot, he won sub vet RU in singles with 99. In 2019 he won B class singles

at the Nebraska State shoot with 99. He won 1st place mid yardage at the Iowa Park Zone shoot with 96. He won sub vet champion at the 2019 Oklahoma State shoot with 97. At the Southwestern Grand he won 1st place in a handicap. And he also won 22-24 yard champion at the Tucson Autumn Grand. At the 2021 Tucson Spring Grand he won doubles RU with 98, and the HAA-B class champion. At the 2021 Tucson winter chain shoot he won B class champion in the Yuma doubles event. Dennis says his most proud moments has been watching his grandson, Kenyon Bert, grow from a young, unsure, boy learning the basic of trap shooting to a confident, competitive shooter. In 2020 Keyon was one of 14 Oklahoma All American shooters. Dennis Patrick became a "Mega Target Member" shooting 23,500 targets in 2019. Dennis has made many new friends during his shooting career.



Jeff & Paula Trayer 2020 Hall of Fame

Jeff was 1st introduced to trap shooting by his Dad, Harold Trayer, an avid hunter and trap shooter. After winning a vehicle in 1973, Harold started a local trap club, where Jeff said he has many fond memories. He 1st shot trap in 1977. In 1999 at the Kansas shoot, he won the instate RU in the Handicap Cham-

pionship. At the Grand in 2017, 2018, and 2020, Jeff won Handicap and Doubles awards. At the Southwestern Grand in 2017 and at the Hartland Grand in 2017, 2018, and 2019, he won several single awards. At the Oklahoma State Shoot in 2017 he won A class singles with 197. In 2018 he won A class doubles with 98 and A class doubles in the SW Zone with 98. In 2020 he won champ in the Finkle Handicap with 96, SW Zone sub vet doubles with a 99. Paula joined him in trap shooting when she shot her 1st registered targets in 2017 at the Turtle Creek GC in Manhattan, KS. Paula said they have traveled many miles shooting together in 9 states. She said one of the best parts of trap shooting is the wonderful friends that one makes. In 2018 Paula won O/S lady 1 singles and handicap champion at the Iowa State Shoot. In 2019 she won Lady 1 Missouri fall handicap with 98, Arkansas O/S Lady 1 singles, Texas State shoot O/S Lady 2 Lone Star singles, Memorial Handicap, and HOA Champ. In 2020 she won Arizona State shoot O/S Lady 2 handicap with 97 and Texas State shoot O/S Lady 2 singles RU. Paula and Jeff have been on the state team several times. They have also won the "Husband and Wife" at the Oklahoma State Shoot in 2019 and 2020. They are both All Americans in the last 2 years. Jeff also enjoys managing ATA Shoots at the Oil Capital Rod & Gun Club and the Tulsa Gun Club.

ENTRY INFORMATION

This printed program will govern our 2021 Oklahoma state shoot. All interpretation of the program will be made by OTSA officials and their decision will be final. ATA rules will be strictly enforced. An event will begin immediately following the previous event so if you schedule late in one event and early in the next, you may miss your squad. The OTSA reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event or limit entries to said event. OTSA may refuse any entrant.

The OTSA will be giving 122nd Oklahoma State Shoot pins as you enter the program.

PRACTICE TRAPS

Practice starts Tuesday, June 1st at 9:00. All other days the practice trap will open at 8:00 am. Practice traps may be closed if needed for events. Practice targets are \$7.00 for 25 targets.

ENTRY

We will open for registration on Tuesday, June 1st at 8:00 am, so that you may enter. Come early and avoid the rush. (If a shooter has entered and paid for an event, he may go back and enter options later so long as that event has not started.)

Checks, Payments & Overpayments

Anyone who presents a check at any shoot for fees and targets that is returned for insufficient funds or for other causes may not compete in any registered shoot until full payment has been made to the individual or club to which it was presented. Clubs receiving such check shall report the name and address of the shooter issuing the check to the ATA. No second party checks will be accepted.

Shells

Shooters may furnish their own shells, including reloads. If you want your empties, put them in your pocket. Do not pick up empties from the ground. Shell specifications will be governed by ATA rules.

Targets

Targets will be White Flyer orange dome, and will be set according to ATA Rules.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARDS

The \$20 fee for this award is a tax-deductible donation to the Hall of Fame. The purpose of this donation is to further the Hall of Fame expansion and worthy projects such as the Youth Trapshooting Program. All donors will qualify for the Hall of Fame Awards. Your entry card shows this contribution and is your receipt. The Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Monies will be paid out in three Lewis Classes. 60/40 high gun each class. Again the \$20 fee is a contribution and in turn you will be eligible for the Hall of Fame Contributor Awards, which are a thank you for the contribution and is in no way to be considered a purse.

^{**} Any shooter, age 18 or under, may shoot for \$28.00 per event, plus fees, unless options are played. In such cases, the shooter pays regular prices.**

Classification

Classification is based on this year's average, last year's average or the last 500 targets, whichever is highest. Any shooter who has registered less than 500 Singles, 500 handicap or 300 doubles for the current year or previous year will be required to shoot penalty yardage and classification.

All ties will be carried over by sub-event to the next like event of the shoot except for handicap events. Contestants will receive three calls for shootoffs. Anyone who does not answer a call for shootoffs will forfeit their right to any prize or trophy.

The Oklahoma State Trap and Skeet Association Annual Meeting will be held Sunday morning at 8:00 am. Oklahoma State Teams, Hall of Fame Inductees, and all elections will be held at this meeting.

Special Event will be held Saturday at 7:00 pm. (No phone entries)

Payoffs

Payoffs will be made starting at noon the following day for Tuesday through Friday's events. Any error in posted scores have to be brought to management's attention immediately following the posting of the scores. Once payoffs have started, there will be no changes made in the option calculations. All payoffs for Saturday and Sunday's events will be mailed. Checks will be mailed by Tuesday, June 21, 2021. Payoff sheets mailed for Saturday & Sunday events only.

All trophies must be awarded by the Trophy Committee. No trophies may be taken by a winner until signed for with the trophy Committee. We will not ship trophies. Contestants can win only one trophy in each event. Please pick-up trophies daily to avoid Sundays long delay.




