2024 Hall of Fame Inductees

The OTSA Board of Directors voted to induct two of our younger shooters to the Oklahoma Trapshooting Hall of Fame. Both represent the State of Oklahoma, & the State Trapshooting Association with aplomb. Their entire lists of wins are far too long to include in this limited space.



Kya Funkhouser

Kya Funkhouser began shooting in 2018 while in the eighth grade at Navajo Public School. During her six years of breaking clays, she claims a multitude of trophies & titles. She started out her shooting career by capturing the Female Rookie of the Year in 2018, winning the OKSSSP State Team Title with teammates, & Lady Club Shoot Runner Up Champion in 2021. From there she progressed to AAA-27-AA status, with four 200 straights in singles, four 100 straights in doubles, & 40-plus 100 straights in singles by the 2023-24 shooting year. She earned a spot on the ATA All American Open Team in two years (2022 & 2023), a feat no other female shooter in the ATA has accom-

plished. She was the first Female Oklahoma shooter to break 100 straight in doubles. She has shot in the Grand American Champion of Champions & registered 100 x 100. Through the years, Kya won numerous titles at multiple Grand American Shoots, SW Grand Shoots, & at Kansas, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Texas, & other State Shoots. She made the Oklahoma State Team five years in a row in four different categories. She also made the ATA Sub-Junior All American Team in 2020, the Junior All American Team in 2021, & now sits on the 2024 First-Team All American Junior Gold Team.

Kya is currently a member of the Western Oklahoma State College Shooting Team that captured several titles during the 2023-24 year. During all this, shooting, she has maintained an honor roll status in her grades.

Kya also finds time to work with elementary students, TSA Students & with members of the shooting sports team at Navajo Public School in Altus. She helps with the family farm & ranch responsibilities & reaches out to help elderly neighbors with bottle calves.

Kya is an avid hunter, fisherwoman, & artist. She loves helping others when she can & gives 110% in all she does. She was in love with shotgun sports from the first shot & received many awards while shooting in junior high and high school.

Clay Laughlin



Clay Laughlin brings to the Hall of Fame a wealth of target shooting experience that began in 2011. Clay started shooting in 4-H & then moved to the AIM program, where he won many trophies & events. At his first ATA Grand American in 2017, Clay won the Sub-Junior Champion title & High All Around Class B Champion. From there he won numerous trophies at the ATA Grand American, AIM Grand American, & events in the Oklahoma, Kansas, Missouri, & Texas State Shoots. He has won numerous trophies in singles, doubles & handicap. Shortly after he began his ATA shooting career, Clay brought home a Trap & Field Handicap Championship on the 23-24.5-yard line, just one exam-

ple of winning his way back to the 27-yard line. One significant handicap trophy was the Kansas State Preliminary Handicap Champion in 2023. Clay also won Singles & Doubles Championships in that same shoot. Every year, he came home with trophies in Singles, Doubles & Handicap Championships won at shoots he attended. In June 2023, Clay attained his Grand Slam. He has been on ATA All American Teams in 2021, 2022, & 2023 and the Oklahoma State Team numerous times, making captain of the AIM Junior team in 2018 and co-captain in 2019. Clay holds AA-27-AA averages & yardage today.

In 2022, Clay shot with the Western Oklahoma State College (WOSC) Shooting Team in Division 4, placing 5th overall at Nationals. During this competition, Clay shot skeet, super sporting, sporting clays, doubles skeet & doubles trap reflecting his all-around shooting abilities.

Off the shooting line, Clay became a certified NSSSA Referee in 2019. Currently, Clay is the Trap Director at the Ada Skeet & Trap Club, assisting in trap & field maintenance. He served the Durant FFA chapter by setting up & managing the shotgun range from 2015 to present. He served as range safety officer at Bryan County 4-H Shooting Sports practices, & from 2013 to present taught gun safety to shooters in a variety of age groups on county, district, & state levels. He has also worked at the Grand American in Sparta, Illinois in scoring & filling trap machines.

Clay's accomplishments are lengthy, but the bottom line is that he is a dedicated Oklahoma shooter, supporting and enriching shotgun sports in Oklahoma. He has represented Oklahoma in many organizations at local, state, & national levels. ENTRY INFORMATION

This printed program governs our 2024 Oklahoma State Shoot. Interpretation of the program are made by OTSA officials & their decisions are final. ATA rules are strictly enforced. An event begins immediately following the previous event so if you schedule late in one event & early in the next, you may miss your squad. The OTSA reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event or limit entries to said event. OTSA may refuse any entrant.

The OTSA starts giving 125th Oklahoma State Shoot pins when shooters cashier for Event 4. The first 150 shooters will receive a pin.

The cashier, squadding, & classification windows opens each tournament day at 8:00am and closes at 4:00pm, except Sunday. Sunday, June 2 opening and closing times are 9:00 AM and 1:00pm

All single & handicap events are shot 5 targets per post, 50 targets per trap. Doubles events are 50 targets per trap, 5 pair per post.

BANKS WILL BE ROTATED EACH DAY. There is a bank drawing each morning. Bank assignments are posted daily no later than 8:45am in the club house. Shoot management reserves the right to reassign banks and/or resquad shooters at any time to facilitate the completion of an event.

FEES

Daily fees of \$4.00 each for the OTSA and ATA are collected each tournament day.

PRACTICE TRAPS

Practice starts Tuesday, May 31st at 9:00am. All other days the practice trap opens at 8:00am. Practice traps may be closed if needed for events. Practice targets are \$8.00 for 25 targets, & can be purchased at the cashiers window.

MAKE-UP TRAPS ARE LIMITED TO 50 TARGETS

ENTRY

Classification opens daily at 8:00 AM beginning Tuesday, May 30th. Come early & avoid the rush. *Shooters who enter & pay for an event may go back & enter options later so long as that event has not started.*

CHECKS, PAYMENTS & OVERPAYMENTS

Anyone who presents a check at any shoot for fees & targets that is returned for insufficient funds or for other causes may not compete in any registered shoot until full payment has been made to the individual or club to which it was presented. Clubs receiving such check shall report the name & address of the shooter issuing the check to the ATA. No second party checks are accepted.

Sub-Junior & Junior shooters may shoot for \$36.00 per event, plus fees. If options are played, the shooter pays regular prices.

NO RE-SQUADDING OR WITHDRAWING AFTER EVENT STARTS.

SHELLS

Shooters may furnish their own shells, including reloads. If you want your empties, put them in your pocket. Do not pick up empties from the ground. Shell specifications as to allowable shot size, shot load, & speed are governed by ATA Rules.

TARGETS

Targets are White Flyer orange dome, & are set according to ATA Rules.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARDS

The \$20 fee for this award in the Oklahoma State Handicap Championship, Sunday, June 2, is a tax-deductible donation to the Hall of Fame.

The purpose of this donation is to further the Hall of Fame expansion & worthy projects such as the Youth Trapshooting Program. All donors will qualify for the Hall of Fame Awards. Your entry card shows this contribution and is your receipt. The Hall of Fame will retain 50% of the donation while the remainder will constitute the portion to be awarded. Monies are paid out in three Lewis Classes. 60/40 high gun each class. Again, the \$20 fee is a contribution & in turn you will be eligible for Hall of Fame Contributor Awards, which are a thank you for the contribution & is in no way to be considered a purse.

CLASSIFICATION

Classification is based on this year's average, last year's average or the last 500 targets, whichever is highest. Any shooter who has registered less than 500 Singles, 500 handicap or 300 doubles for the current or previous year must shoot penalty yardage & classification

Once a category declaration is made by either a shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final & cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

CLASS ADVANCE RULES

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the classification of any shooter at any time. High scores in Class regardless of category are advanced 1 class. If a shooter earns yardage, it is the shooter's responsibility to see that their average card is properly punched. Class advances begin with Events 4 & 5.

SHOOT OFFS

All ties are carried over by sub-event to the next like event of the shoot except for handicap events. Contestants will receive three calls for shoot offs. Anyone who does not answer a call for shoot offs will forfeit their right to any prize or trophy. All singles & handicap shoot offs are on a 25-target basis & doubles are on a 10-pair basis. HOA & HAA shoot offs are shot as 20 Singles, 10 Handicap, & 5 pair of Doubles. Ties for all trophies in all Handicap events are shot off daily.

PAYOFFS

Payoffs are made starting at noon the following day for Tuesday through Friday's events. Any error in posted scores have to be brought to management's attention immediately following posting of the scores. Once payoffs have started, there are no changes made in the option calculations. All payoffs for Saturday & Sunday's events are mailed. Checks are mailed by Friday, June 30, 2023. Payoff sheets mailed for Saturday & Sunday events only.

SPECIAL EVENT

A Special Event is held associated with the 2024 Oklahoma State Championship Handicap. Auction will occur on Saturday, June 3rd in the club house at 6:00pm. No phone entries. Beers & Burgers are available for a donation to the OTSA Improvement Fund.

STATE MEETING

The Oklahoma State Trap & Skeet Association Annual Meeting is held Sunday morning at 8:00am. Oklahoma State Teams, Hall of Fame Inductees, & all elections are held at the meeting.

CAMPING

Camping spaces with electric & water hook-ups are available by paid reservation only. For reservation information, contact Ron Bliss (405) 641-8979 or countryequipment2@gmail.com. Fee is \$150 for the entire shoot year. Your space is not guaranteed until payment is made. Payment needs to be made by May 10, 2023 to guarantee your reservation.

VENDORS

WATCH FOR YOUR SQUAD

The first event of the day starts at the time listed in the program. Your squad <u>will not wait more than three minutes</u> for you to take your post. If you are not present within the allotted time, your name is scratched and your squad will proceed without you. <u>You will not be paged.</u>

BLOCKING POSTS AND SQUADS

The computer program used for the State Shoot was developed to reserve posts only for short time periods, primarily to allow shooters in line to squad together. Also, blocked posts have no names attached to them. Management will not guarantee blocked positions for any shooter. ALL POSITIONS BLOCKED THE PREVIOUS DAY ARE RELEASED AT 9 AM.

HIGH ALL-AROUND AND HIGH OVFRALL

Class High All-Around is figured on Championship Singles classification as of Event #12. Class High Overall is figured on Singles classification for Event #4.


TROPHIES

All Trophies must be awarded by the Trophy Committee. No trophies may be taken by a winner until signed for with the Trophy Committee. Trophies will not be shipped. Contestants can win only one trophy in each event. Please pick-up trophies daily to avoid long lines on Sunday.

100 & 200 STRAIGHT PINS

100 & 200 (perfect) straight pins were designed exclusively for the state shoot, & will be awarded in each discipline. These pins will not be awarded at other shoots, & only one pin is presented to successful shooters for each discipline. There are no carry-overs.

ATA RULES WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE WINNERS OF ALL TROPHIES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER TROPHIES ARE FURNISHED BY OTSA OR ATA. ATA RULES REGARDING "FALL BACKS" ARE USED TO DETERMINE ALL WINNERS.
