## *Academics – Integrity - Marksmanship*

- The ATA has announced the AIM online zone shoot. It will be held in May on the following weekends: 5-6, 12-13, 19-20, or 26-28. Each shooter is required to shoot 100 singles on one of these dates. It doesn't matter what club one registers these targets; it can even be out of state. If a shooter enters more than one place or event, his best score will be recorded. If he/she shoots a 200 target event, it will be averaged to get to number broke per 100 targets.
- The state AIM championships will be held at OTSA, El Reno, May 29th. We will shoot 100 singles, 100 handicap, and 50 pr doubles that day. Plan to attend. If we are going to enter teams for this shoot, I need coaches to let me know who will be on their teams.
- The 2019 AIM Handicap Championship will be held October 6-7 and 13-14. Participants must compete in a 100 target registered handicap event at any gun club hosting an ATA registered shoot. Check the rules for the event at the AIM website ([www.aim4ata.com](http://www.aim4ata.com)).
