<p><u>Colors: Mix with open medium.</u></p> <p>Lavender or Heliotrope, Cool Shadow, Mixing or Strong Yellow, Pecan Yellow Red, Dark Green</p> <p>Large glass for water Soft oil free brush approximately ½" Oil free tile & palette knife(cleaned w/ alcohol) Water base medium, Fine point Sharpie pen, Resist & brush, DRY Chartreuse, DRY Turquoise, DRY Lavender or Heliotrope china paint Lavender oil Hair dryer Regular china painting supplies</p> <p><u>Before Class:</u> Pre-trace the pattern using waxy transfer paper or graphite which works best for dry dusting). Dry dust with Lavender china paint and fire at 017. Resist flowers before the class. This will save a lot of time in class.</p>	<p><u>Colors:</u></p> <p>Regular clean palette (student's choice of colors) with freshly mixed paints. OPEN medium.</p> <p>Brushes (square shaders, mops, synthetic brushes #8 or #10, filbert's or cat tongues) <u>*I will have extra to use or for sale.</u></p> <p>Palette knife Wipe out tool Extra small tiles Towels Lamp (If you need it)</p> <p>I use odorless turp. Please NO turpenoid natural. Mineral spirits are okay.</p> <p>I will have some paints for sale but please bring your own in powder form if you have it. If you have something special you would like to paint, please bring it sized to the tile you are painting on. I reserve the right to okay it.</p>	<p><u>Colors: Mix with open medium.</u></p> <p>Mixing Yellow, Yellow Brown #2 (or Pecan) Brown, Chartreuse, Deep Blue Green, Shading Green, Brown Green Banding Blue, Violet Yellow Red, Black</p> <p>Mineral Oil or Orange Glow Furniture Polish Open Medium Resist Viva Paper Towels (prefers smooth) Graphite Paper Scissors & Tape Brushes: Square Shaderes#10, 8, 4, Scroller, Liner Wipe out tool Brush Cleaner Sharpie</p>
