Message from the President

WOCP Porcelain Artists,

Just a quick note to answer some questions I have been getting about the 2019 World Show here in Omaha.

- 1. Hotel block of rooms will be held at the \$95 per night price until July 17, 2019. If you haven't yet booked your room, you have less than 2 weeks to get it reserved. You can call Aretha directly to book your room at 402-517-3083.
- 2. State tables will be available for clubs to display their work. Please call or email Connie Fuhrman to let her know that your state will be represented in the vendor showroom. Her number is 402-468-5426 or conniefuhrman@gmail.com.
- 3. Auction donations are still needed. This is our way of raising money for the show. Your donation does not need to be a painted porcelain piece. We have a variety of items sewn, carved from wood, eatable, and more.
- 4. The Wednesday painting demos by Jane Wright and Vida Klocke have been cancelled due to other activities taking place that day. Wednesday will be busy as the first day of registration. The dealer meeting will take place at 1:00pm and the general meeting is scheduled for 4:00pm. We will direct, you that day, as to where the meetings will take place. Students of the Paint-In and the Round Robin event will register on Wednesday as well. Registration will open at 8:00am. Please consider the Paint-In students need to be in class at 9:00am for their final day of painting. Let's let them register first so they will not be late for class.
- 5. The vendor showroom opens Thursday morning at 9:00am with our ribbon cutting. Vendor showroom closes at 5:00pm Thursday and Friday. Vendor tear down at 12:00pm Saturday. Vendors will be provided a boxed lunch Thursday and Friday. Please let Connie Fuhrman know how many will be in your booth.
- 6. The vendor showroom will be open for dealers to set up from 8:00am until 5:00pm. Dealers please be ready for early shopping which begins at 6:00pm after the general meeting. This is our vendor appreciation event. Dealers will partake in

the food and drinks available that evening at no cost, we appreciate you! The food will be served in two locations in the vendor showroom which allows shoppers to eat and spend money at the same time. A cash bar will be available.

- 7. We need demonstration teachers. Show us what you can do. The demonstrations will be held in 3 paint in rooms from 9:00am until 11:30am, 2 demos per room. The afternoon demos will take place in the vendor showroom starting at 1:00pm ending at 5:00pm. Demos will take place Thursday and Friday only.
- 8. If you are planning to go on a tour, PLEASE let me know. If you need an Uber or Lift ride somewhere, also let me know. Call me at 402-490-3166 or email me APaintersCollection@gmail.com. There is a hotel shuttle to take you to and from the airport.
- 9. Several famous artists have painted giant bowls to be auctioned on Thursday night. You won't want to miss this. I have seen many of the bowls—you won't believe your eyes. Bring your checkbook and/or credit card. The Thursday event is our "Black and Bling" night. Wear your best bling and put on something black. I have a Frank Sinatra crooner coming to sing to each of you. I also have an auctioneer coming to take your bids. There will be prizes and surprises for this event.
- 10. Paint-In and Round Robin events still have seats available. Please support these wonderful artists giving of their time to teach and help you think out of the box in the world of porcelain art.
