



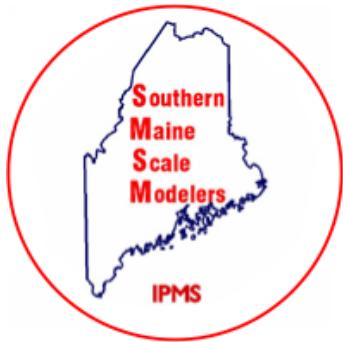

March is another club project night. We will be working on helicopters for the


meeting....let's see what you can do!!

Meeting adjourns at 8:38pm







Finished with Testor's One Coat Laquer's, Tamiya paints

1/12 1969 Camaro Z28 (Revell)


