As onto the carpet one of those little suckers drops

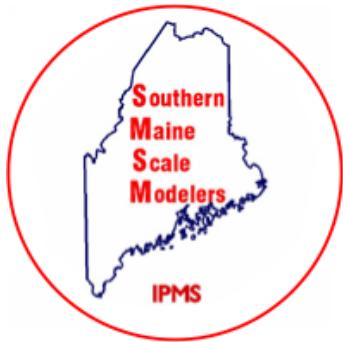
I guess this "hobby" is more like an obsession

Treasurer: Dave Osborne


Secretary: Norm Jordan



Show and Tell: There were three models by three modelers. Bob Piere won the Model of the month for his 61 Impala




### 1/24 1961 Chevrolet Impala SS (AMT)
