- Is required for entry and use of the Carova Recycle Center
- Beach Driving Rules (along the dune line between 9-5pm)
 between milepost 14.5 and 17. Restrictions will be in effect beginning the Friday before Memorial Day through Labor Day with parking passes being required between April 30 and October 1.
