Blue Star Salute Fundraising for Wreaths Across America

The Blue Star Salute Foundation Inc. (BSSFI) has been the primary fundraiser for Wreaths Across America at the Alabama National Cemetery since the cemetery opened in 2009. We have provided 85-90% of the funding to place a live Maine Balsam Wreath on each Veteran's grave for over a dozen years.

The fundraising requirement has grown dramatically, from 354 wreaths required in 2009 to 7,352 required in 2020. See the chart to the right showing the growth over the years. Our fundraising efforts in the early years were very successful, allowing us to build up a reserve balance for future growth. In recent years, especially during the COVID plagued 2020, our fundraising efforts did not keep pace with the growth and these reserves have been depleted.



In 2020, we raised \$30,485 which at the price of \$15 per wreath is a small fraction of what was needed. Had it not been for a limited time discount program offered through the National Wreaths Across America Organization and our prior years reserves, we would have been 3,386 wreaths short.

We are a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation founded in December 2005 to honor our military, our veterans, and our Fallen heroes. Over the years we have proudly done this through the following ways (in alphabetical order):

Alabama's Fallen Heroes - We take our "Faces of the Price of Freedom" display all over the State of Alabama to schools and Veterans Events to ensure that our fallen heroes are never forgotten.
