# Cultural Evening

Cultural evening is Cultural Performance presented by participating Countries. This culture performance will be showing the videos of the musical instrument, dances from every country, singing, and so on. Time duration for each participating Countries is 3 minutes maximum.

Upload 1 (one) cultural performance video of your group or your country to the link <http://bit.ly/ProjectPresentationAndCulturalPerformance>.

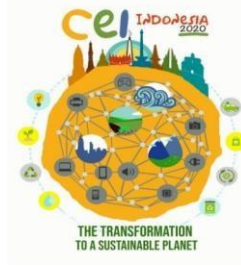
Please make sure that your video is in mp4 format, and the size is about 45-50 MB. We expect to receive this by **14th September 2020**. If you miss the deadline, your performance will not be presented in the Cultural Night Performance .

Below are some Q&As related to this year's cultural celebration, a traditional element in every CEI conference. Normally live on a stage, this year virtually from across the globe. Read along to learn more and see what your delegation should do in order to take part.

## **CEI 2020 - Everything you need to know about the virtual Cultural 'Evening'**

### **Q: What is the CEI Cultural Evening?**

A: The CEI Cultural Evening is a tradition that **celebrates** culture and diversity. It is an element of the conference program where can have fun with their peers, interact with other delegates, expand their knowledge of the world and its diverse cultures through performances, and be proud of the nations they represent. Given that environment is often



closely linked with culture, understanding different cultures and traditions helps students become better Caretakers.

**Q: Can I take part in the Cultural Evening?**

A: Yes! Every delegation gets allocated a timeslot during the cultural celebration, regardless of the size of the delegation. Everyone matters! You can showcase any element of your culture and country.

**Q: What should I do a delegation?**

A: Every delegation should **prepare 1 video of any performance that represents your culture** (e.g. dances, orchestra, drama, poem, language, food, etc.). In previous conferences, the showcasing of performances was done in front of a live audience (all other delegates), however, as CEI 2020 will be a virtual conference, performances should be pre-recorded and the final product should be in a video format (e.g. M4A, MP4, MOV, AVI).

We would also like to carry on the tradition of **showcasing traditional costumes**, just like in the previous conferences. So, for each delegation, please send 1 short video saying “hello we are Caretakers from...” in your own language wearing your traditional costume (**5-15 seconds long**) and **1 photo** of your delegation wearing your traditional outfit to be made into a collage.

**Q: There is multiple delegations from my country, how does that work?**

A: This is where another Caretaker characteristic comes in: working together! Collaborate with your country’s delegations on a joint video and submit that one. Every country has one



single slot in the Cultural Evening, due to time limits we cannot have multiple per country. Use it as an opportunity to highlight the diversity within your country!

You are, however, able to submit a photo of every delegation in traditional costumes and a video of every delegation saying 'hello we are Caretakers from ...' in the national or local language.

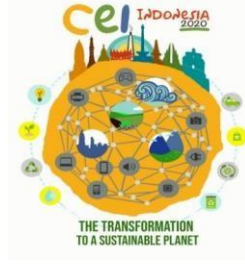
### **Q What are the guidelines for my Cultural Evening video submission?**

A: To allow for a smooth ceremony, we ask you to stick to the following:

1. One video per country (see above)
2. All content in the video should be original to each delegation. If you use material that is copyrighted, please provide citations or copyright to the original source.
3. Please be mindful of appropriateness (e.g. nothing discriminative, disrespectful, violent, etc.)
4. **Video submissions can be maximum 3 minutes long.** We hold the rights to edit your video to shorten it if it exceeds 3 minutes.
5. See above for the traditional costume showcasing: a video of 5-15 seconds long and a delegation photo in costume.
