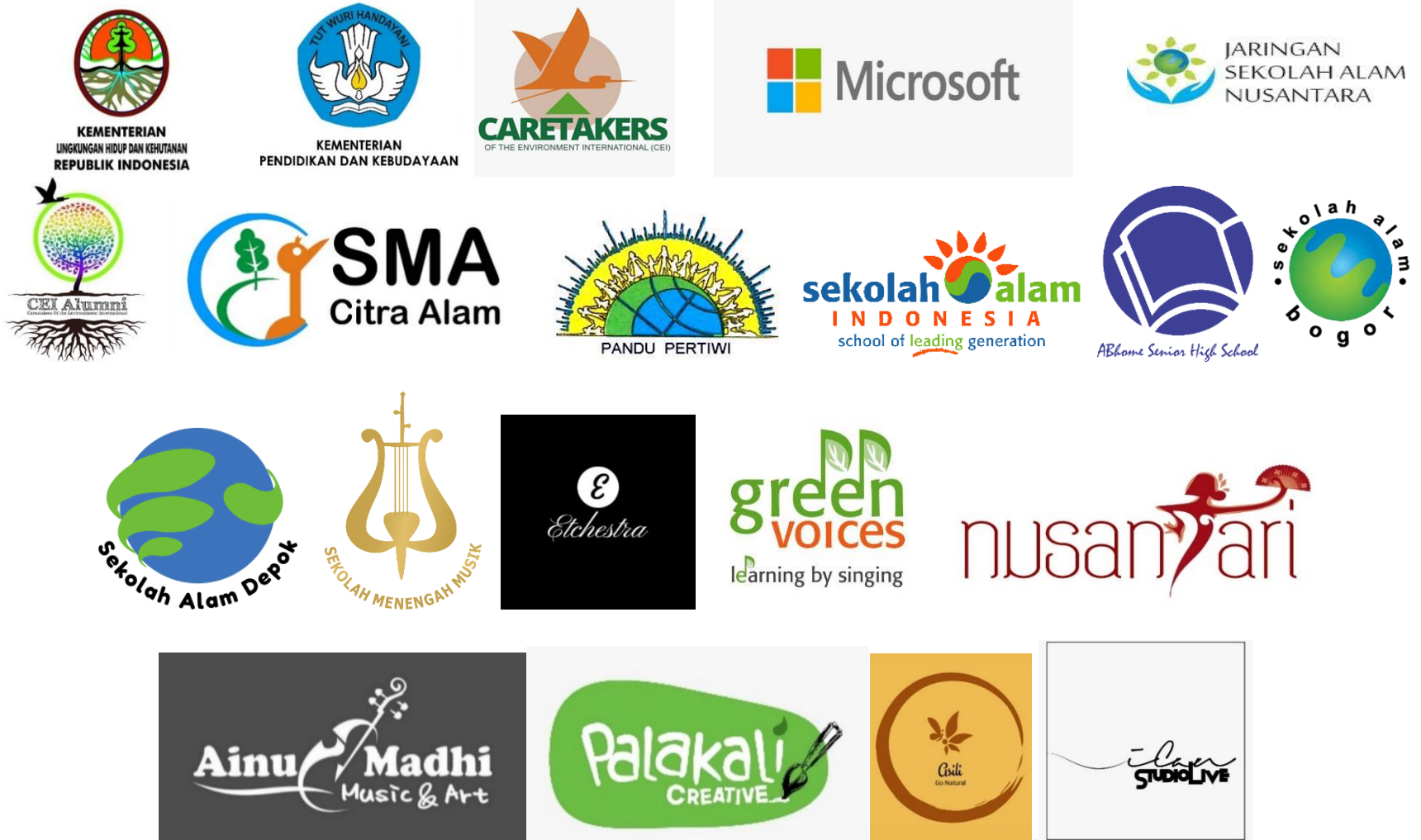

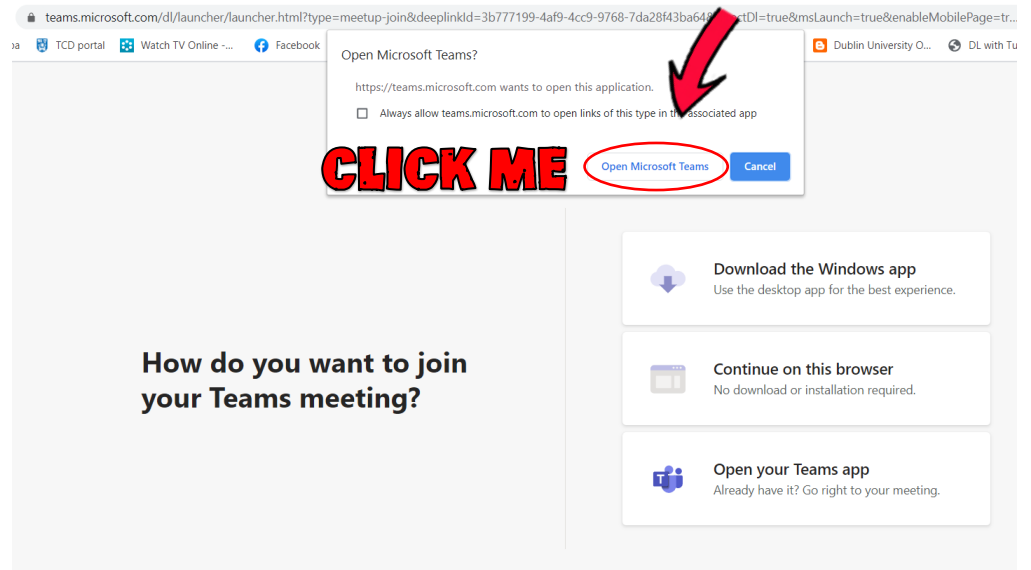
3. DESCRIPTIONS AND LINKS



WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ALL OF THESE SESSIONS?

1. LIVE STREAM WATCHING

This means there is a large session with too many participants for a simple call. Instead we encourage you to watch and comment using our social media such as on YouTube CEI Indonesia (http://youtube.com/channel/UC0NhMLFUN5_C2GsnhbUI3-A/live) CEI Alumni (https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCWfFn_YXh1LYPW2meaMrH4Q) or Facebook (<HTTPS://WWW.FACEBOOK.COM/CEI2020/LIVE/>) We do this particularly for sessions that involve watching videos, speeches or performances such as the Opening Ceremony and Cultural Evening. For some sessions we exclusively have a livestream so take note of these! **Please note that these sessions will also be available after the live stream ONLINE TO WATCH AT YOUR LEISURE.**

2. SEPARATE GROUPS IN DIFFERENT CHANNELS

This means you have chosen or been placed into a one of several parallel sessions. For the projects you will have chosen to join either the full projects, 48-hour projects

or Brainstorming for 2021 project sessions. These all take place in different channels with different facilitators (see below for further information). Similarly, for the workshops you will have indicated your preference for one of 6 general workshop sessions or one of the 4 teacher workshops which will take place in different channels (see below for further information).

3. SDG GROUPS








All participants have been divided into 7 different Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) groups. This is like the typical clans/colours/fruits of previous conferences. Each group has an alumni who will lead your group for the week. When it is time for an SDG group activity you will join your group on your personalised channel. See the table below for the different groups!

4. ALL PARTICIPANTS ON SAME CALL

All participants will join on an open Microsoft Teams where you can join with your video, but please keep your microphone muted until you are encouraged to turn it on! Please use the chat function as your primary source of comments and questions!

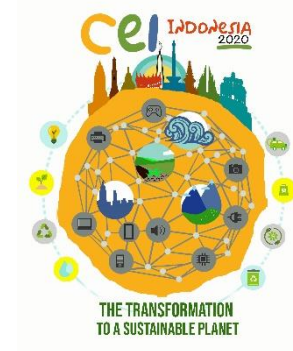

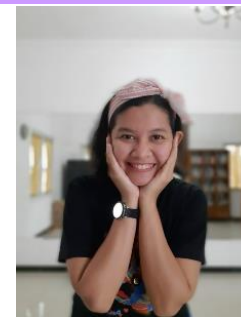

Butet wrote a successful book "The Jungle School" which we strongly recommend to add to your reading list! Butet received various international awards such as - UNESCO's "Man and Biosphere Award" 2001, TIME Magazine's "Hero of Asia" 2004, "Ashoka Fellow" 2006, "Asia Young Leader" 2007, "Young Global Leader" 2009, Ernst and Young Indonesian Social Entrepreneur of the Year 2012 and the last "Asia Nobel Prize" Ramon Magsaysay Award 2014. Butet wrote her experiences on a book titled, Sokola Rimba (2007). The book was translated into English in 2012 (The Jungle School). The Jungle School Film came out in 2014, screened in various international film festival and received international awards. Both the book and film has been very helpful in shifting the paradigm of thinking about indigenous communities.

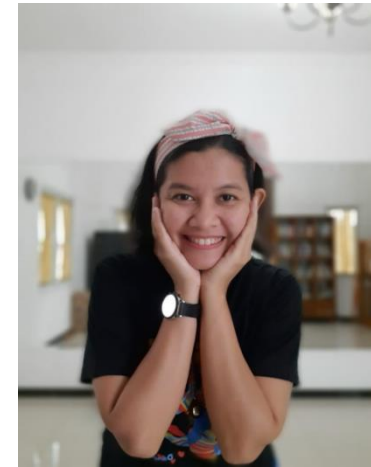

Eco Printing

Eco printing is a technique of dyeing fabrics through direct contact between leaves, flowers, stems - or parts of plants that contain colour pigments - with certain materials. The resulting fabric motif will usually always be different even though it still uses the same type of leaves from the same plant. This colouring can be made with a variety of simple techniques, one of which is the steaming technique. The way to identify plants that can be used is simple: namely by smelling, rubbing and soaking the plants. Fabrics that can be used for Eco printing are fabrics from materials derived from natural fibres, for example, cotton, silk, wool, etc. Eco printing has many benefits, one of which is that it is more environmentally friendly than other textile products that produce a lot of waste.

The Floating School

Speaker: Rahmat Hidayat (The Floating School/Future Leader Connect 2019) Rahmat Hidayat is one of the founders of The Floating School. The Floating School is a semi-traditional boat that transports books, stationary, education materials and the mentors themselves around the three islands of Pangkep: Saugi, Satando and Sapuli. The school began in early 2017 and 83 young people now attend. The focus is on bringing a creative and fun learning experience to these children. The school goes to the students, not the other way around. *"We have designed our own non-formal educational programme that fits with the context of life on the islands. For example, those working in fishing have a responsibility to preserve the marine life, so we teach environmental protection and discourage destructive fishing practices."*
