



Studio Dress Code 2025/26

The dress code of Elevé Dance Company is enforced so that all students can participate in class comfortably while still allowing instructors to see body lines and placement.

All Classes

Hair should be secured up and out of the face (ballet should have a bun, always), no jewelry, and appropriate shoes should be worn at all times.

1. Combo Classes

- a. Students must wear a leotard and tights. The leotard may be any color or style. Tights should be pink, black, or tan. Students must wear tights so that shoes fit easily – please, no bare legs or feet, please!
- b. Please do not allow children to wear skirts to class, as they can be distracting. No street clothes, t-shirts, etc.. Students who do not comply with the dress code will be given a warning. After the first warning, they will not be allowed to enter class.
- c. Dancers who are in JAZZ class may wear dance shorts (tight fitting) over the leotard and tights.

2. Int. - Adv. Levels (Jazz, Contemporary, Tap, Leaps & Turns, etc.)

- a. Students may wear any color and style of DANCE ATTIRE. Appropriate clothing includes but is not limited to: hot pants, jazz pants, Capri pants, leotards, fitted dance tops, half tops, etc.
- b. No street clothes or loose-fitting shorts/pants. NO GYM SHORTS OF ANY KIND. ALL CLOTHING MUST FIT TIGHT TO THE BODY.
- c. NO T-SHIRTS EXCEPT FOR WARM-UP. Loose t-shirts, tank tops, etc. should not be worn during class time.

3. All levels of ballet and point

- a. A leotard and tights must be worn in ballet class.
- b. Students in ALL ballet/pointe classes MUST wear pink tights with any color leotard.
- c. NO LOOSE CLOTHING of any kind should be worn AT ALL. Ballet skirts are allowed if permitted by the teacher.

4. Company choreography classes

a. Students must wear ALL **black** dance clothes to choreography classes/rehearsals. Please ensure you are in DANCE attire that is fitted to the body. Clothing should not have a pattern, writing, design, etc.

5. Boys

a. Boys in combo or level classes should wear athletic shorts or pants, and a t-shirt that fits the body.

b. Boys should wear black ballet shoes and black tap shoes.

* Failure to dress appropriately may result in dismissal from class after an initial warning.
Parents will be notified if students have received a warning.*
