



1. Description

2. Objective

A degree in a field related to art will also be a plus. Instructors will be expected to submit a course outline that covers topics like, *Color Theory, Composition, Value, Form & Structure, Brushwork and Perspective*.

3. Compensation

Instructors should determine their own compensation for the workshop.

4. Eligibility Requirements

This is an open request for proposals. We will evaluate all applications based on the Evaluation Criteria.

5. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based upon:

- Education
- Awards & Distinction of Instructor
- Proposed Content & Methodology
- Cost of Instructor
- Length of Proposed Workshop and Cost
- Availability of the Instructor to fit schedule

6. Application Procedure

Applicants should mail an application packet in by the deadline for consideration. Packets should include:

- Artist Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 5 Examples of Work
- Course Outline – Broken down by Day
- Ability to Teach Multiple Paint Mediums
- Education Experience will be a plus
