Exploring Our Fabrics

Step 1: Select swatches for review

Getting started with stock fabric is easy.

Browse our collection of fabrics Thecol.com and select up to 20 fabrics to receive as swatches.

Simply add the fabrics you like to your wish list and checkout when ready.

Details:

- *Lead time: 3-5 days*
- *Fee: Free - client pays for shipping*
 - *Minimums: None*
- *Requirements: Shipping address & courier account*
 - *Notes: Limit of 20 swatches per order.*
 - *Some fabrics may be out of stock*

Getting bulk yardage

Process

Submit order

Let us know:

- *Which fabric you want*
- *How much fabric you need*

Pay invoice

- *We'll invoice you for the fabric requested*
- *Fabric ships 7 days after payment clears*

Receive product

- *Fabric is shipped directly to our workshop*
- *Our QC team verifies fabric quality*
- *Fabric is used for sample making or production*

Step 2: Order bulk fabric

Whether for sampling or production, ordering bulk quantities of stock fabric is super fast.

Details:

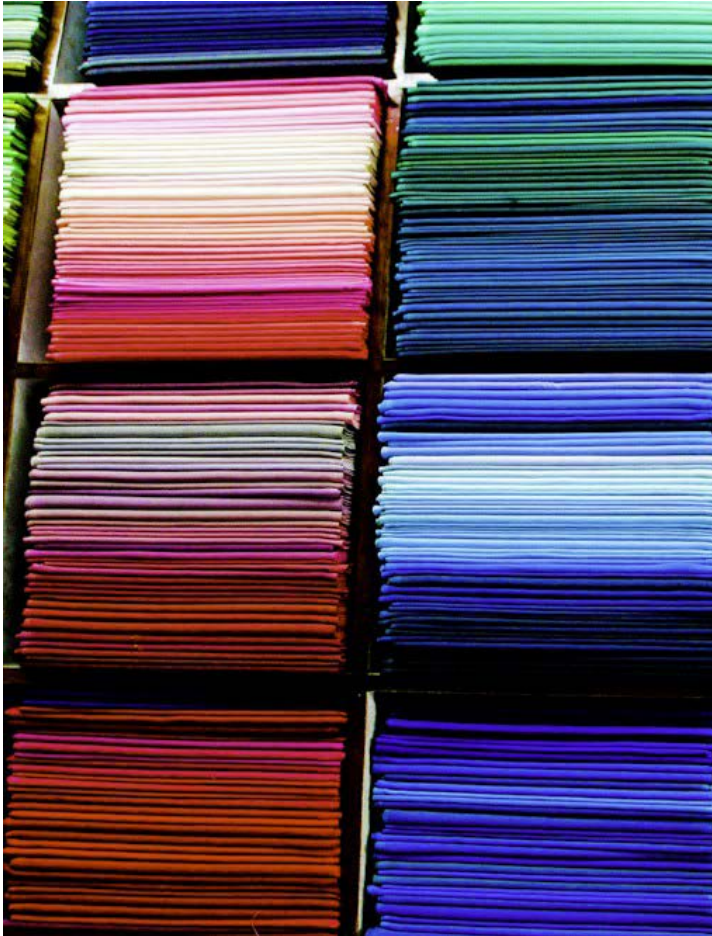
- *Lead time: 7 days*
- *Fee: Fabric price + shipping*
- *Terms: Payment in advance*
- *Sampling minimums: Starting from 20m*
- *Production minimums: Starting from 200m*

Stock fabric: best practices

Here are some helpful suggestions to help you get the most out of our Stock Fabric program:

- *Move fast: Since stock inventories fluctuate, if you find a fabric you like, reserve the volume you need before someone else buys out the inventory*
- *Plan ahead: When order sample yardage, it's best to order enough for 3 samples and any size samples you may need to save time and money later. That's why we enforce a 20m sampling minimum*
- *Be flexible: There is no way to stock every possible fabric and print design in the world, so if you have a very specific design in mind, chances are you won't find it in stock*

Frequently asked questions



How does stock fabric quality compare with other fabrics?

The fabrics we stock are top quality and checked at the mill and when they are delivered to our workshops.

What happens if the fabric I want is out of stock?

Depending on the fabric, some are re-milled and will be stocked again shortly. Others may take longer to restock or maybe discontinued. Depending on the time line of your production you can elect to wait or select another fabric

Are Town Hill stock fabrics certified?

Yes, all our stock fabrics are Oeko Tex Standard 1000 certified. This assures that at each step of milling process, from raw fibers to weaving, no harmful or illegal substances were used.
