To start the sourcing process, we'll need a reference sample from you so we know what to look for.


Once we have the reference sample, we'll be able to advise you on the best sourcing strategy based on:

- The volume of material you need
- Your production timeline
- Your specific design requests

Step 2. Choosing the right sourcing strategy

We tailor our sourcing strategy based on the amount of material you need and how specific your preferences are. Our goal is to give you a strong option no matter your request:

- Stock suppliers we have a large network of stock fabric warehouses that may have what you want on hand
- Greige suppliers for common materials, we buy bulk greige and arrange custom printing and dyeing as needed
- Mills At higher volumes, we can mill an exact replica of your reference along with any customizations you request

Very specific requests at low volumes may be difficult to source but we will always look for a way to get you the best option.

Step 3. Ordering bulk fabric

Whether for sampling or production, ordering bulk quantities of sourced fabric is super easy.

Details:

- Lead time stock: **7 days**
- Lead time greige or mill: Starting from 35 days
- Fee: Fabric price + shipping
- Terms: Payment in advance
- Sampling minimums: Starting from **20m**
- Production minimums: Starting from 200m

Counter sourcing: best practices

Here are some helpful suggestions to help you get the most out of our Counter sourcing program:

- Provide good references: Our sourcing team is only as good as the
 reference you provide. A poor reference that doesn't truly match what
 you want means we're not going to find what you want. We may have to
 start over, make the sourcing process longer and potentially delaying your
 production
- **Explore:** The best counter sourcing starts with designers who have taken the time to explore different fabric options and are confident with the references they have chosen
- **Be open to compromise:** Especially if you are doing a low volume production, getting the right fabric often requires balancing price, volume, and design.

How do I know if you'll be able to source my fabric?

The experience of our sourcing team means we can usually give you a rough idea how difficult it will be to source your fabric. After we review the reference material, we'll be able to give you the proper expectations so you can make a good decision on how you want to go about sourcing.

What happens if you can't find I want?

We try our best to avoid this issue right off the bat by telling you upfront if the material you need is hard to source and needs to be custom made. In cases where we cannot find something after we start sourcing, we'll refund you the sourcing deposit

Can I trust the quality of the materials you source?

Not only do we give you materials samples for approval, but our experienced QC team inspects all your materials before they are used for production to ensure your products meet our quality standards.
