

Dear Zephyr Christian Family,

I imagine you could use some encouraging news today, right? Well, let me share with you something that I think is encouraging. If you've attended one of our New Member Classes, you know that during the first class we spend time talking about the historical roots of Zephyr Christian Church – that we are part of the Restoration Movement and how that movement came about and what that movement stands for. Probably the most contemporary statement of the purpose of the Restoration Movement I have seen is something that Matt Proctor, president of Ozark Christian College, wrote recently: *Christian unity under biblical authority for evangelistic mission.*

But if you've attended one of our New Member Classes, or if you know your Restoration Movement history, you know that this unity movement split into three fellowships: the Disciples of Christ, the non-instrumental Churches of Christ, and the Independent Christian Church.

Now for the encouraging news – over the years, the Disciples of Christ churches have become a liberal denomination, and it has greatly affected their attendance. They had a membership of 2 million in 1967, but in 2022 they reported a membership of 277,864 with attendance at their services of 89,894. However, within that denomination there is a conservative renewal movement that is happening called the Disciple Heritage Foundation. It started in 1985 and has grown to a network of more than 150 churches – they are trying to influence the Disciples of Christ back toward Biblical Christianity. They describe it as "trying to navigate being a theologically conservative church in an increasingly liberal denomination." As the Disciple Heritage Foundation grows in number and influence withing the Disciples, it opens the door for increasing unity and fellowship with the Churches of Christ and the Independent Christian Churches.

The non-instrumental Churches of Christ has also declined in recent years – those tracking it are predicting that by 2050 Churches of Christ will be about one-third the number of churches and adherents they had in 1985. But efforts for greater unity are happening here also! Several non-instrumental preachers were invited to speak at North American Christian Conventions held by the Independent Christian Churches (when we had the NACC). And there are key players working hard to reunite the Churches of Christ and the Independent Christians Churches. Recently, Harding University (a non-instrumental school) invited preachers from both fellowships to their campus for prayer and to discuss discipleship in an increasingly secular world. Pray these efforts continue.

Every year the *Christian Standard* publishes a growth report for the Independent Christian Churches. It reported in 2023 that the growth rate for Independent Christian Churches was 12.8 percent. More than 70,000 baptisms were reported. And even though we call ourselves "Independent," we are inter-dependent – we work together to support Christian camps, Bible colleges, Good News Productions International, Christ in Youth, and other necessary arms of ministry.

Jesus prayed that His Church would be united. If Jesus prayed for unity, shouldn't we be praying for it, too? And if Jesus prayed for unity, shouldn't we welcome our brothers and sisters of other fellowships? And if Jesus prayed for unity, shouldn't we be working toward being the answer to His prayer? Yes, yes, and yes!

So, the encouragement is that there are efforts toward greater unity and there seems to be a growing desire and momentum toward greater unity within churches that have the common background of the Restoration Movement.

Eddie Cook in Colorado (Thanks, Eddie!) had a few layers that had to be removed by hand before they could be taken off of the truck. Dave's team will start packing the boxes inside the Bible Barn. So far, it appears as if there is a half container load already there. More deliveries are coming soon. I spent Sunday with my sister, Sara and her friends Julie, Laurie, Julie and Daphne at Kentwood Christian Church. Patrick Gill, the minister, and the leadership have been instrumental in collecting Bibles for many container loads. The church actually filled one 20' container by the generosity of their members! We serve an Almighty God!!!


