The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Greg Armstrong.

Introductions of all in attendance was completed.

The May 30, 2017 Neighborhood Watch Meeting Minutes were provided as handouts and reviewed by those attending. One correction adding Donna Lee DeBaets to the list of people present was made. Gloria moved to accept the minutes as corrected. Motion was seconded by Richard. All attending were in favor.

Roberta gave the Treasury Report, indicating a balance of \$2,964.55 as of 06/26/17. Steve made the motion to approve the Treasury Report, Jay seconded the motion and all attending approved.

Roberta reported that 3 new volunteers signed up since the last meeting. James Tucker, Lynda Carroll and her husband will be scheduled for training.

Greg reported that the monthly Puna Watch meeting included the Puna District Crime Statistics and a political presentation by Hawaii County Council Women, Jen Ruggles.

Mark Hauanio noted that he continues to work on the albizia treatments. Anyone wishing to participate should let him know. Greg offered to put the next work day on “LE Next Door” email notifications.

Donna presented the May Loose Dog Report. A total of 11 loose dogs were reported and photographed. There were 0 complaints. Six letters went out including 5 first warnings and one 2<sup>nd</sup> violation. Donna reviewed the LE policy regarding loose dogs. Three letters are sent out to offending dog owners, then the owner is referred to the Hawaii Island Human Society for enforcement.

Richard reported that the By-Laws Committee met to review the current By-Laws for recommended revisions or amendments. Richard, Ross Stadnyk and Gloria volunteered for this Committee. Since the By-Laws were just updated one year ago, the committee found no revisions needed.

Jay reported that the annual Audit Committee consisting of Jay, Jim and James Tucker has not yet met to conduct the audit. Jay will contact the others to set up a meeting.

Greg brought up the recent robbery at the Kawaihae of water sports equipment used by veterans including Soldiers Undertaking Disabled Scuba, Wounded Warrior Project and active military at PTA. Donations

of items such as snorkel gear, board shorts, boogie boards and surf boards are being accepted. Donations can be dropped off at the Leilani Community Office, the Community Garage Sale on July 1<sup>st</sup> and at the July 4<sup>th</sup> BBQ/Potluck. Monetary donations are also being accepted. After a brief discussion it was moved by Mark to donate \$200 to the project, seconded by Sally and all in attendance were in favor.

Greg reviewed the procedure for abandon vehicles parked along the roads belonging to Leilani Estates. Also reviewed were procedures for road hazards, and powerlines.
