Mike Kaleikini from Puna Geothermal Ventures gave a brief update. PGV is the only geothermal site on the Big Island and they supply 38 mw of power to HELCO. They recently completed re-drilling of an injection well and are back to normal power supply. PGV works closely with Hawaii Island Civil Defense in preparation for tropical storms. The State of Hawaii has mandated going to 100% renewable energy by year 2025. Mike invited anyone who would like to tour the PGV plant to contact him.

No Community Police Officers were in attendance so no community crime statistics were reported.

The August 30th Neighborhood Watch Meeting Minutes were provided as handouts and reviewed by those attending. Mark made the motion to approve the August minutes and Jay seconded the motion. All attending were in favor.

Roberta gave the Treasury Report, indicating a balance of \$2,040.78 as of 9/26/16. Mark made the motion to approve the Treasury Report, Ross seconded the motion and all attending approved.

Roberta trained two new LENW volunteers this month – one walker and one driver.
