- 1) **Call to Order** at 7:00 p.m. by Vaunda Stenzel. Introductions followed. Ms. Stenzel welcomed everyone and said the Volunteer sign-up sheet was located at the back table in case anyone wanted to sign up for a patrol slot.
- 2) **Community Police Report:** Ms. Stenzel explained that Officer Kamalii would not be at the meeting tonight because he was on vacation. No report except for the abandoned vehicles on Malama, Pomaikai and Hookupu. Mr. Hauanio was going to check on them.
- 3) **New Driver/Recruitment:** Rob Olchin introduced himself and said he is a Real Estate Appraiser. He also is interested in Neighborhood Watch. Mr. and Mrs. Bond expressed an interest in Neighborhood Watch. Ms. Van Goethem said she would speak with both of them after the meeting.
Ms. Turkovsky inquired if the Neighborhood Watch Walkers could have some type of waterproof tablets. This will be forwarded to Mr. Armstrong.
- 4) **Dog Issues Report:** Ms. DeBaets will investigate the Hookupu dog issues after a report by Mr. Messenheimer. Ms. DeBaets reminded everyone to take pictures in the street; if the dog is in the driveway, it will not hold up. She wanted to remind everyone to take a picture of the mailbox to show end of pictures about each dog and where you think they may live. She said you can email her pictures if you take with your own camera to leisure88@sonic.net. There were 28 reports and eight (8) first warnings were sent out.
- 5) **Block Captains:** Mr. Hauanio said he has been emailing block captains with progress reports. He will update email addresses. There are no issues to report. Ms. Whitefield stated on N.
