

## LEILANI ESTATES NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

Minutes of February 24, 2015 Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Jay Turkovsky, NW Coordinator

Attending: Greg A., Lynn VB., Richard S., Mark H., Jane W., Russ S., Roberta VG., Jan G., Gloria T. and Officers Kamalii and Waipa.

Community Policy Officer Davy Kamalii presented the Leilani Estates and Puna crime statistics for January 28 – February 24, 2015. There were no crimes reported in Leilani Estates during this period.

Officer D. Kamalii noted that the declared State of Emergency only affects the lower Puna area that has been impacted by the lava flow. Accordingly, there has been a decrease in some crime statistics (notably “theft”) due to closure of businesses (e.g. Malama Market) that routinely report shoplifting and that some of those responsible for criminal activity have focused more recently on the upper Puna area (e.g. Mountain View).

Officer Kamalii also noted that bike patrols will begin in Leilani Estates soon – they are currently just waiting for uniforms. He also plans to bring a PowerPoint presentation on stolen vehicles to show at the March meeting.

Jay informed the group attending that he is stepping aside as NW Coordinator due to personal commitments and time restraints. Greg Armstrong is stepping in to head up Leilani Estates Neighborhood Watch going forward.

Greg indicated that Neighborhood Watch drivers will begin taking photos of loose dogs again. Photos should be taken with the NW camera and noted on the NW Drivers’ Log. Greg will download the photos as necessary and work with Pake regarding tracking and follow-up with the owners.

Greg noted that Donna D. has been updating the Drivers Schedule and may have recruited some new or returning drivers.

Mark H. volunteered to head up coordination of Block Captains meetings. Mark also offered to train anyone who may be interested in driving a 1-hour night shift.

Lynn VB drafted a brochure for Neighborhood Watch and will finalize it for printing and distribution at the LCA Office, posting on the website, etc.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm.
