BURGLARY (continue): 18

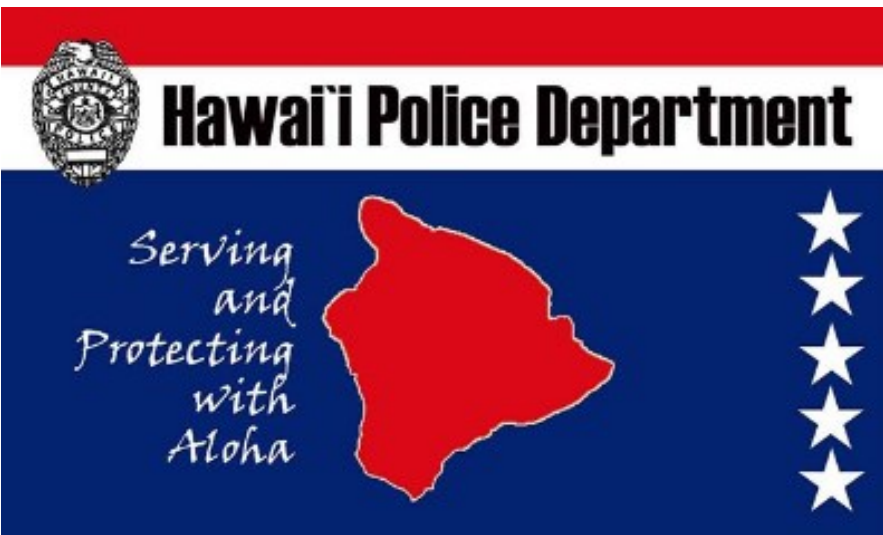
