LCA has been granted a meeting with key people in the County administration to discuss the future of the Fissure 8 eruption site. *(The meeting is currently scheduled for: **Friday, Jan. 29, 2021 from 1-2pm.**)* We hope to have a productive dialog concerning the County's lawful responsibility for creating and enforcing clear land development policy, interest in a tourist viewing area, and discouraging destructive activities within the lava-covered area in Leilani Estates.

We expect to speak with representatives from the Mayor's office, the Department of Public Works, the Planning Department and the Kilauea Recovery Team at this meeting
