

**LEILANI ESTATES NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH MEETING MINUTES**  
**January 29, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm by Greg Armstrong. Greg noted the passing of Donna DeBaets, a long-time Neighborhood Watch volunteer, former LENW board member and Loose Dog Coordinator.

The Community Police Officer was unable to attend due to illness and no Puna crime statistics were available. The November 27, 2018 Neighborhood Watch Meeting Minutes were provided as handouts and reviewed. Mark made the motion to approve the November minutes and Andy seconded the motion. All attending were in favor.

Greg gave the Treasury Report, indicating a balance of \$1,848.92 as of 1/29/19. Mark made the motion to approve the Treasury Report, Gloria seconded the motion and all attending approved.

Alice is working with the Driver Logs and requested volunteers to write or print out their names (not just initials) at the end of the notes for their shifts.

Andy gave an update on recent activity and steps being taken to deal with squatters/trespassers in Leilani Estates. Two houses on Maile have been boarded up and 18 individuals were arrested by HPD for multiple violations, including outstanding warrants, jumping bail, etc. A third house is being worked on and Andy requested that LCA be notified of any suspected squatter houses. Greg announced that the LCA Board has developed a procedure and form for this purpose.

Richard presented the December-January Loose Dog Report. Six dogs were observed off-leash during this period – 4 were photographed, 2 first warnings and 1 repeat offender referred to HIHS. Richard also noted that five new Neighborhood Watch volunteers were trained in December and January.

Mark updated the group on the Block Captains' meeting that was held recently. Although we have some new block captains, there are still streets without them. Any volunteers for block captain should contact Mark. The current block captains and their assigned streets are:
