

LEILANI ESTATES NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH MEETING MINUTES
May 28, 2019

Present: Greg Armstrong, Ross Stadnyk, Richard Skidmore, Mark Hauanio, Andy & Pam Andrews, Alice Lindahl, William Wong, Marianne Farrell, James Tucker, John Segalla, Gary McMillan, Jim & Julie Harding and Community Police Officer Eddie Cardines.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by Greg Armstrong.

CPO Eddie Cardines noted that there were 5 reported thefts and 1 burglary last month in Leilani Estates, plus another burglary on Malama Street where the victim did not want to press charges. In general, criminal activity has been declining since the increase when we returned after the evacuations. CPO Cardines alerted the group of several individuals who have outstanding warrants and if seen, to call 911.

The April 30, 2019 Neighborhood Watch Meeting Minutes were provided as handouts and reviewed. Mark made the motion to approve the April minutes and James seconded the motion. All attending were in favor.

Greg gave the Treasury Report, indicating a balance of \$2,225.40 as of 5/27/19. Mark made the motion to approve the Treasury Report, James seconded the motion and all attending approved.

Candidates for the four positions on the LENW Board are: President/Coordinator – Greg Armstrong, Vice President – Ross Stadnyk, Treasurer – James Tucker, and Secretary – John Henry. No additional candidates were nominated from the floor. All attending were in favor of electing these four candidates to serve on the LENW Board for two years, through May, 2021.

Andy gave an update on the Squatter Elimination and Crime Reduction (SECR) Committee activities. Friday they will be meeting with Rick Damerville from the County Prosecutors Office to discuss options for properties with suspected drug-related activities. Three properties where squatters were recently evicted are now in the process of being sold – good news!

Alice noted that there are still areas of Leilani Estates that need block captains. A map depicting where there are current block captains was distributed. Mark noted that there was a block captains meeting on May 16th and the next meeting will be scheduled for June 23rd at 13-1155 Kahukai (corner of Maile).

Richard presented the May Loose Dog Report. Only 2 dogs were observed off-leash this month. One may have belonged to a visitor rather than a resident and the other dog belongs to a property on N. Pomaikai that has been problematic for the past 2 years.

Greg is pulling together the documents for the LENW Treasury Audit (2017-2019). Jim Penny and Cheryl Kaupp will review the documents when Jim is available.
