High Winds

March 17, 2025

On Friday March 14th due to high winds in our operating areas, there were several instances of wind related damage. Compressor sheds were damaged, solar panels ripped off and concrete towers on a drilling location blew over damaging the pump truck.

Be aware of the wind direction and fall radius of temporary equipment. Any material that could become airborne should be secured.



High Wind Guidelines

- Be aware of equipment that may have a higher profile and be susceptible to tip over when exposed to strong wind. Mark off a potential fall zone to raise awareness. (Examples: cement bins, silos, sand boxes, light towers, pipe racked in derricks)
- Crane use during wind shall be based on the manufacturer's guidelines, load impact, height and visibility.
- Loose equipment/material should be secured to prevent it from becoming airborne and damaging other equipment.
- Be aware of changing conditions and shifting winds.
