

## **Simultaneous Operations Communication**

It was discovered that a construction crew installing gas and water lines for Blue Mountain Midstream had dug a trench and buried the ReCoil layflat line being used to actively supply the Frac Job taking place on the Smarty Jones Pad while pumping a stage. This was an activity needed to allow construction equipment to access the right-of-way and had been safely done previously multiple times as instructions prior to the sale of Citizen III to Validus Energy were to proceed without disrupting frac operations. Had the line been damaged during active fracking, the risk of operational damage due to sand with no water would have been significant.





## **Simultaneous Operations Communication**

When activities potentially impacting another contractor/operation must take place, the supervisors of the two activities must communicate to develop a plan to move forward.

This plan should minimize safety and environmental risk and maximize operational efficiency. It does not need to be in writing.

All potentially impacted groups should be consulted during the development process.

No one may move or operate equipment/valves not belonging to their company without approval.
