

Our Category-IV Master course is a hybrid format that meets the ISO 18436-1 and ISO 18436-2 requirements while allowing you to complete the first half (Part 1) of the course through online learning via the web. The second half (Part 2) of the course is delivered in a live classroom setting where you complete your training and optionally take the Category IV certification examination.

You will learn advanced measurement signal processing techniques, including torsional vibration and cross-channel measurements, dynamics including mass/stiffness/damping and natural frequencies, modal analysis and operating deflection

shapes, orbit and centerline analysis, rotor dynamics, correction techniques including isolation, damping, and tuned absorbers, and other advanced topics. Upon completing the course, you will be qualified to lead condition monitoring teams and will have a deep understanding of machine dynamics and failure modes. With your knowledge and qualifications you are able to design tests to solve difficult problems and identify underlying issues to prevent reoccurrence. You will carry the highest regard in the field of machine condition monitoring.
