(1)	You will make a vow to the LORD to complete the 180 day program, to surrender your heart, your time and attention to Him.
(2)	You will complete the study curriculum to the best of your ability.
(3)	You will serve the LORD in works of ministry as follows: week day outreach breakfasts, church nursery (approved women only), evangelistic outreaches, housekeeping chores, work training program, and other duties as specified.
(4)	You will obey the ministry leaders with a submissive heart. The Bible says: "Obey the rulers who have authority over you. Only God can give authority to anyone, and He puts these rulers in their places of power." Rom. 13:1

"Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God." Romans 13:1.

The focus must be the Lord Jesus Christ, and consequently, according to His Word, human authority is to be respected and obeyed. If you willfully violate rules of this ministry or other instructions from its authority, you will be called to account for your behavior through restrictions and other disciplinary measures. These punitive actions are for the purpose of allowing you to ponder your attitude and commitment to Christ and the human authority placed over you, giving you an opportunity to prove your repentance and the integrity of your commitment.

- \_\_\_\_(4) You will attend the daily discipleship classes, completing all book and memory work assigned by the leader, to the best of your ability.
- \_\_\_\_(5) Refrain from kindling any personal relationships with the opposite sex during this time. A smile and a hello are appropriate. Men and women do not sit together in church, women minister to women, men with men.

  Remember, for 180 days, no one but Jesus!

## RESIDENTIAL RULES

(1) Performance of all duties assigned to you is expected.
(2) You must be in your room by 10 p.m. Lights out one hour later.
(3) Appointments will be recorded by the Resident Manager on the master calendar in advance. Be prepared to give the following information: Location of Appointment, Contact Person and Phone Number. Remember, your R&R day is your day for such appointments.
(4) Off-campus passes are required for all nonscheduled activities and appointments. They may be obtained in the Church on the Street discipleship offices.
(5) You will make your bed and tidy up your own area before leaving for breakfast.
(6) All prescription medications will be retained and distributed by the Resident Manager or another designated staff person.
(7) Your choice of music and literature should reflect a wholesome lifestyle.
