Exhibit A

All sidewalks replaced will have to meet ADA requirements.

All sidewalks shall have a four feet minimum width.

All sidewalks shall have a minimum four inches concrete depth.

All sidewalks shall have a three inch minimum stone base.

Any new concrete that abuts named streets must have ADA mats.

Village will reimburse residents 25% of total cost after 100% of original bill is paid. A paid receipt must be provided to the Village with a request for reimbursement showing payment in full.

Village will pay up to a maximum of \$7.00 per linear foot. A linear foot is defined as a one foot by four foot section of sidewalk.

A signed contract between owner and contractor before any work started.

Costs shall be reimbursed on a first-come-first-served basis of the appropriated funds.

A maximum of \$2,100 of reimbursement shall be provided during a six-month time period between January 1st through June 30th; and from July 1st through December 31st for each applicant. An applicant is defined as per property and/or per household.

RESOLUTION NO. 17-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CONCRETE SIDEWALK REPAIRS MADE BY RESIDENTS THROUGH A SPECIAL FUND FOR SIDEWALK REPAIR.

WHEREAS, there are damaged sidewalks in the Village of Deshler;
WHEREAS, some of the damage may be attributed to Village tree damage, or Village related utilities;

WHEREAS, some damage is attributed to residents and normal wear and tear;
WHEREAS, the Village sees a need to have sidewalks in a good state of repair;

WHEREAS, the Village is willing to partner with the residents and reimburse residents Twenty Five percent (25%) of the costs of sidewalk repair;

WHEREAS, the Village will reimburse the citizens for sidewalk repair out of a special fund that will be initially funded with Twenty thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$20,000.00);

WHEREAS, the Village will reimburse at a maximum Seven and 00/100 dollars (\$7.00) per linear foot, a linear foot defined as a one foot by four foot section of sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, the Village believes it to be in the best interests said repairs meet minimum requirements and eligibility rules in order for the Village to reimburse citizens for repairs of sidewalks.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF DESHLER, HENRY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1: The Village of Deshler Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to place Twenty thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$20,000.00) in a special fund for reimbursements of sidewalk repairs.

Section 2: The Village of Deshler Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to reimburse citizens (25%) of the costs of sidewalk repair, if the repairs meet the minimum and eligibility requirements in Exhibit "A," on a first come first served basis until all funds are expended from said reimbursement fund.

Section 3: The Village, once all the funds are expended, may authorize additional funds to go into the special account for sidewalk repairs.

Section 4: That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution, were adopted in open meetings of the Village Council, that all deliberations of this Village Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance withal legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its final approval.
