Best wishes for a happy and holy Christmas season!

Congratulations to Council 8086 for winning the Fishers of Men Award, announced back in June by Supreme. The four-month competition included a cash prize of \$2,000 and a film crew from Supreme to film a special event, to the council with the top overall recruiting council in each of the KofC Insurance territories.

No. 1 in the Southeast Territory – comprising 13 states and Puerto Rico – was Council 8086 with 51 new members. That's enough to make three-star council. Since then, 8086 has recruited additional members. 8086 was also second in the state for percentage, gaining an additional \$250.

If you recently receive an envelope from Florida KofC Charities with motto, "Florida Knights support Special Olympics," please consider returning it with a small donation. There will also be a similar envelope for vocations in December and the popular KofC Helping Life mailing labels in January.

The three programs make up the "Triple Crown." **Last year, only ONE of the 260 councils in Florida earned the Triple Crown.** Our individual small gifts add up, and will significantly impact the tremendous work of Special Olympics, educating seminarians and saving (and enhancing) lives.

Our next Cor meeting will be on Tuesday, Nov. 25, at Sacred Heart, at 6:30 p.m. Our main topic will be the fourth chapter in the life of our Founder, Blessed Father Michael McGivney. Everyone is invited to join us for an hour of prayer, reflection and fellowship.

Looking ahead, our **December Cor meeting will be Tuesday, Dec. 16, at Our Lady of Hope at 6:30 p.m.** We will get back to the fourth Tuesday when we resume in January.

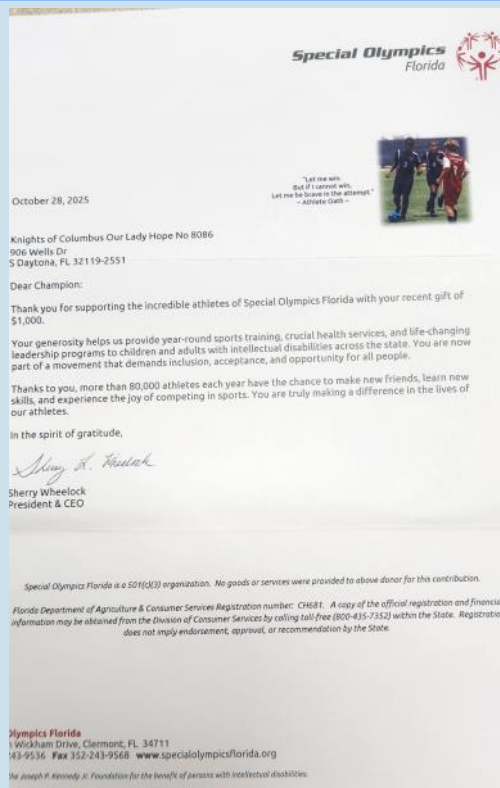

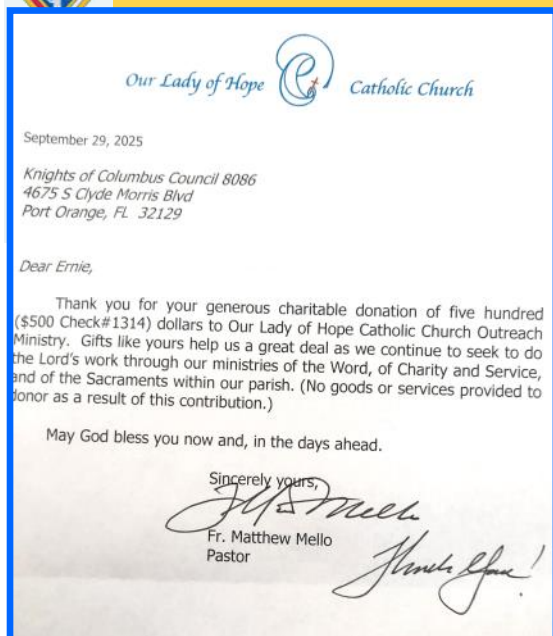

The Florida State Council is proud so many Florida Councils were recognized on the Fishers of Men membership incentive program. The program ran from July 1 to October 31. Councils were grouped by territory. Florida is one of 14 jurisdictions in the Southeast Territory. Incentives were awarded to the top 3 councils in total number of new member intake, and for the top 25 councils in percentage attainment of the annual membership intake goal.

Florida had the top council in the territory for total new member intake. Congratulations to Our Lady of Hope Council 8086 in Port Orange. They brought in 51 new members during the 4-month incentive period. They won \$2000 for a council/parish event. They will have a film crew from Supreme at the event to document what they did and how they recruit, so the rest of the world can learn from their success.

Florida had 10 of the top 25 councils in the Territory for percentage of quota gained during the 4 months. These councils were also eligible for cash awards to be used for a council/parish event. The top 3 finishers received special recognition with larger awards.

Florida is proud of St. Peter the Apostle Council 15779 in Trinity who finished second (380%) and earned a \$1000 award.

4th through 25 place finishers receive a \$250 award. Florida has 9 councils in that group.
