# **Grand Knight's Report**

Brothers,

As we begin the new Fraternal Year, I want to thank you for your confidence in electing me as your Grand Knight. We started the new year with a great Induction Ceremony thanks to Fr Matt, Deputy SK John O'Malley and his trusty Warden SK Sam Tedesco. I want to thank Vito and Gina for their outstanding work providing a wonderful Induction night dinner. Special thanks also to the donors, who made it possible for our attendees to dine at no cost. Lastly, thank you Maureen Kealhofer for your help with the church screens and all you do for our Church community.

So what is my leadership style? Servant leadership is a leadership philosophy in which the goal of the leader is to serve. This is different from traditional leadership where the leader's main focus is the thriving of their organization. A servant leader shares power, puts the needs of the members first and helps members develop and perform as highly as possible. Instead of the members working to serve the leader, the leader exists to serve the members, focusing on them and helping them to become wiser, more autonomous, and, in our case, more likely to become servants to God and our Church community.

Currently, we have about 35 elderly and disabled who have requested our help. That puts us at about eight houses per each four-man team. We are short about 10 volunteers.
