Goat Anti-Human Albumin, Goat Polyclonal, Antigen Affinity Purified

General description: Goat polyclonal antibody to human Albumin. Albumin is a soluble, monomeric, globular unglycosylated serum protein of 66 kDa, which comprises about one-half of the blood serum protein. It has a role in stabilizing extracellular fluid volume and is a carrier protein for fatty acids and steroids.

Host species: Goat

Immunogen: Human Albumin

Production Procedures: Immunogen affinity purified from goat antiserum.

Storage: short term @ 2 - 8°C; long term, frozen in working aliquots @ -20°C, avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

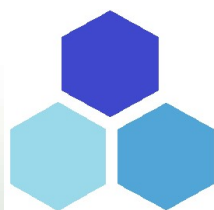
Buffer: 10 mM Phosphate Buffered Saline (PBS) containing 0.05% (7.7 mM) Sodium Azide

Usage: ELISA, Lateral Flow

Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution OF 1:1,000 – 1:30,000 immediately before use.

Notes:

- Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid.
