Overview:

Gracepoint Christian Academy exists for the glory of God, the edification of His Church, and the evangelization of our community. We desire that all persons, namely the children entrusted to our care, know Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, being rooted and grounded in God's Word, and living an overcoming, victorious Christian life.

It is our desire to nurture, not replace, the role of the family and the church in the bringing up of a child in Christ-likeness. Gracepoint seeks the cooperation and active involvement of the family in the education and nurture of the specific needs of each individual child, as parents carry the biblical responsibility and role as primary educator of their children.

"And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbor as thyself." (Luke 10:27) An essential aspect of our worship of God is to love Him with all of our mind. We aim to develop an atmosphere of academic excellence as the soul of each child is directed God-wards for the building up of Christ's Kingdom.

Vision:

As a Christian School, we train young men and women to view all of life through the lens of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and Him Crucified, thereby raising up a generation passionate to lead, teach, and model what loving God and serving others looks like before a lost and hurting world.

Mission:

Being directed by God, we seek to guide each child, by way of example and instruction, to the pinnacle of God's love for the world found in His Son, Jesus Christ, and His finished work on the Cross. From this foundation, we will apply every other truth as it regards this life, raising up a generation that is prepared to face the onslaught of an ever-changing world and culture, grounded biblically and strengthened spiritually, academically, physically, and socially.

Our History

In the latter part of 2013 and early 2014, local Jonesboro Pastor, David "Bubba" Walsworth, felt impressed of the Lord that a Christian school was to be opened in Jackson Parish. A building that had once operated as a nursing home sat vacant on Highway 167 – the ideal locale for a Christian school. Pastor Bubba shared this God-sized dream the Lord had planted in his heart with his fellow compatriots in the ministry at their local church, and together they went to prayer. For months, this 'vision' began to grow in their hearts as they would take the long way home some nights in order to drive around the vacant building and pray.

By December of 2014, an executive school board had been established and pro bono legal counsel had been procured from the Louisiana state capitol in order to accept the official act of donation of what had been the former Jackson Parish Manor Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. Gracepoint Christin Academy, an official Louisiana not for profit organization, was formed and officially stationed on the grounds of 1691 S. Hudson Avenue...all by the grace of God.

With the building now in possession, the faith journey had just begun. Pastor Bubba began to cry out to God, "Lord, you've provided the building, but we don't even have the money to pay insurance!" Mere minutes later, a call came in that a \$4,000.00 check had just come in the mail from an anonymous donor on behalf of the school.

This kind of miraculous provision became a regular occurrence over the next few months. The board would meet in the now Gracepoint lobby, discussing the renovations that needed to be accomplished and paid for by their anticipated start date of August 2015. There were absolutely no means in their own hands but reminded of missionary C.T. Studd's faith motto as he pioneered the China Inland Mission, they knew that "God's work, done God's way, will never lack God's supply."

Around 9:30 PM one of those very evenings, gathered around on plastic paint buckets in the lobby, a call came in from a dear brother stating that he needed to meet with the board at the school that night. He had come to deliver a \$12,000.00 check from an anonymous donor. They cried and thanked God together for His miraculous provision. The Lord was truly using the foolish things of the world to

confound the wise (I Cor. 1:27) and showing His strength to be perfect in their weakness (II Cor. 12:9).

Pages upon pages would not give this miracle story the justice that it deserves in recounting all the ways that God provided as we kept (and continue to keep) our eyes on His Son, Jesus Christ, and all that He has made provision for in His "a school." The Lord has been working on and building us, His Church. We are learning, sometimes through harder lessons than others, that <u>HE</u> is more than enough; that not only did He provide salvation and eternal life for us through His own precious blood – but He has provided everything we need for our daily living and sanctification ("…hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness…" II Peter 1:3).

By and only through God's grace, we are taking the pen out of the hand of the Enemy who has been staking his claim on the next generation and penning their demise for too long. We preach "Jesus Christ and Him crucified" – who He is and what He has done – believing that as we are faithful to preach and teach Truth, our children will give Jesus the rights to their life and allow Him to write a more magnificent story than they could have ever dreamed or imagined.
